It is election time of the year!

The election of club officers and directors will take place on Tuesday, May 22nd. Members with at least two years in good standing are invited to run for any available position. There are four directors and all officer slots open for the running. Nominations will be accepted, and then closed at the April meeting.

By-Law Changes

At the annual election we will also be voting on the following by-law change: - Article IV, section 4 currently states that the president may not serve more than two consecutive terms. The Board has voted to have that changed to three consecutive terms. He must still be nominated, and elected to each one year term in order to do so. There are three advantages to this. It aligns with the terms of board members, so we don't have board members dropping out to run for president. We don't have to search for someone to run for president as often, and it is usually hard to find a candidate. Additionally, it takes some time for the incoming president to learn the ropes, then a year and a half into his term he is already on his way out. If he could serve three terms it would be more efficient. As stated, he would still need to be elected, so if he is not working for the club's best interests he could be voted out after one or two years.

This will be opened to the floor for discussion at the April Open meeting.



Please take note, some of you have mentioned you are not able to open the newsletter via email due to it's size. Remember you can always download it on your computer from the website.


