

JUST IMAGINE!

Imagine, for a moment, that someone asked you to present Jesus to others . . .

What would you say? What would you do? What would you wear? Would you be nervous? Would you be excited? Would you ask others to help you?

Everyday, we have this opportunity by the lives we live and the words we speak! Do we convey a loving, caring God who is concerned for ALL children? Do we show patience and forgiveness when others could care less? Do we take time to listen to the stories, problems, dreams, feelings of others?

Some in our midst have made a special commitment to do just that. We call them Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Most frequently, we find them around the altar as they present to us the very Body and Blood of Jesus. In one brief moment, their relationship with Jesus is expressed and shared.

These ministers can also be found in nursing homes and private homes, wherever our sisters and brothers seek God's presence and love. Sometimes, they are called to the bedside of one who is drawing their last earthly breath. Occasionally they may lead others in Eucharistic Adoration and prayer.

While this is a tremendous responsibility, they nourish and strengthen themselves by God's grace through frequent celebration of the Sacraments and quiet hours spent in reflective, Eucharistic prayer. They walk with the One whose love they seek to share; they strive to grow in God's way.

Occasionally, such as this Sunday afternoon at 1:00, they gather for more formal instruction. The informal questions and answers, as well as the sharing of experiences, not only helps others in knowledge, but especially in inspiration and encouragement. A time for prayer brings them to the Lord.

I especially encourage you to pray for these men and women who say "yes" to God's call. While God does not expect perfection, God does ask for an open and loving heart.

The Rite of Election of Catechumens and the Call to Continuing Conversion of Candidates

This past Sunday, March 5, the RCIA members, their Sponsors and their families traveled to St. Michael's, Findlay, to meet with the bishop for this next step in the RCIA process.

The Rite of Election of Catechumens is not our choosing of candidates for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist or even the bishop's choosing. God has already chosen (or elected) all of us. The Rite of Election is the opportunity to recognize and to express clearly that these catechumens have enough knowledge, understanding, and desire, to receive the grace of the Sacraments and to live as followers of Christ in love and service.

The Church recognizes the Candidates for Continuing Conversion, who have already been baptized and who are preparing to complete their initiation for Full Communion through Confirmation and Eucharist. Deep respect is given to their grace-filled baptisms, but the Church now charges these candidates to use the Lenten season as a time to hear again the call to conversion and to be faithful to their baptismal vows.
