



## Impartation / Refreshing

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in

heaven bless you and your house and keep you (Num. 6:24). The Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Grace be with you. (2 Tim. 4:22) Glory to God in the highest, our Father! (Luke 2:14) We do not come to the Father based on our own worthiness, or on the worthiness of you and your family, but by Jesus Christ, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ and Him in us, we come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19); for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing! (Rev. 5:12) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Messiah (John 1:41), abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), in Christ we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. O Lord God of hosts, hear our prayer; give ear, O God of Jacob! Selah (Ps. 84:8) Let the name of our Lord Jesus Christ be magnified forever! (2 Sam. 7:26) The God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome (Deut. 10:17), Who remembers us in our lowly state, for His mercy endures forever. (Ps. 136:23)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), Lord even of the Sabbath (Matt. 12:8), may the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17), give to you and your family the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you and your people may know what is the hope of your calling, what are the riches of the glory of your inheritance in Jesus Christ, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward you and your house, according to the working of His mighty power. (Eph. 1:17-19) In Christ we pray that God will count you and your family worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and every work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you and your family, and you and your people in Him, according to the grace of your God and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Thess. 1:11-12) To God your Savior, who alone is wise, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. (Jude 1:25)

In Christ we ask in the name of His only begotten Son (John 1:18), Jesus Christ (John 16:23), Him who sits on the throne (Rev. 5:13), that you and your people may be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you and your family may have a walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and long suffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified you and your house to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. He has delivered you and your family from the power of darkness and translated you into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom you have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (Col. 1:9-

14) In Christ we pray that your God and Father would grant to you and your people, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you and your family, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height - to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you and your people may be filled with all the fullness of God. (Eph. 3:16-

19) Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you and your family completely; and your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Thess. 5:23) Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, and the people whom He has chosen as His own inheritance. The Lord looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men. From the place of His habitation He looks on all the inhabitants of the earth; He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works. (Ps. 33:12-15)

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and your God and Father, who has loved you and given you everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you and your house in every good word and work. (2 Thess. 2:16-17) May the Lord deliver you and your family from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and your house and guard you and your family from the evil one. (2 Thess. 3:2:3) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), Him who is true (1 John 5:20), may El Shadda, the All-Sufficient One (Gen. 17:1), make you and your people increase and abound in love to one another and to all, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the

coming of our Lord *Jesus Christ* with all His Saints (1 Thess. 3:12:13); that you and your people may stand with all His saints in glory (2 Thess. 1:10). Let your hearts be encouraged, being knit together in love with God the Father, *Christ* the Son, the Holy Spirit and all the saints, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of *Christ*, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (Col. 2:2:3) In *Christ* we pray the Lord will open to you and your house His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. (Duet. 28:12) In *Christ* we ask our Lord *Jesus Christ* and God our Father to reach out and touch you and your family, to speak to your spirit (1 Cor. 2:13), renew your mind (Rom. 12:2), change your life, create in you a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17), and to pour out His spirit and to fill you and your people abundantly (Titus 3:6), until your is cup running over (Ps. 23:5), the love of God being poured into your hearts, the implanted word overflowing in your hearts (James 1:21). Out of your heart shall flow rivers of living water. (John 7:38) Let you and your house be part of the posterity that serves Him. It will be recounted of the Lord to the next generation; let your house be among those who come and declare His righteousness to a people who will be born. (Ps. 22:30-31) If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through *Jesus Christ*, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. (1 Pet. 4:11)

In *Christ* we pray that God, Who declares His strength among the peoples (Ps. 77:14), would open in you and your people a door for the word, to speak the mystery of *Christ* (Col. 4:3), that the testimony of *Christ* is confirmed in you, so that you come short in no gift (1 Cor. 1:6-7), so that your hearts will be opened to receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you (Acts 1:8), and your minds to believe (Acts 9:42), so that you may make it manifest, and speak as you ought to (Col. 4:4). According to Your mercy remember your servants (you an your house), for Your goodness' sake, O Lord. (Ps. 25:7) Remember your servants (you and your house), O Lord, with the favor You have toward Your people (Ps.106:4); remember the word to Your servant, upon which You have caused us to hope (Ps. 119:49). Oh Lord, grant to Your servants (you and your house) that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through them in

the name of Your holy Servant Jesus. Also, may you and your house pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 14:1), be zealous for spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 14:12), for God distributes to each one individually as He wills (1 Cor. 12:11). Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, "The Lord be magnified" (Ps. 40:16)

In the name of your beloved son (Matt. 3:17), Jesus Christ (John 16:23), Him who is far above principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come (Eph. 1:21), in order to glorify His name, we declare "All spiritual gifts that we have received, in Christ we freely give back to the Father of Lights (James 1:17), and ask that He, the Father of Lights (James 1:17), impart these gifts to you and your family" (Rom. 1:11). In accordance with Rom 1:11, by the spirit of Lord (Zech. 4:6), and by the authority of Jesus Christ (Matt. 28:18) and our Father that is in heaven (Rom. 13:1), let the spiritual gifts of the Father (Rom. 12:6), and of the Son (1 Cor. 12:28), and of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 12:7-11) be imparted to you and your family. In Christ we ask the Father, in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the true vine (John 15:1), that through the Spirit of the Lord (Zech. 4:6) that He impart, stir up and refresh to you and your family the following gifts (Rom. 1:11): Word of Wisdom (1 Cor. 12:8), Faith (1 Cor. 12:9), Word of Knowledge (1 Cor. 12:8), Discerning of spirits (1 Cor. 12:10), gifts of Healing (1 Cor. 12:9), Ministry (Rom 12:7, 1 Cor. 12:28), Working of Miracles (1 Cor. 12:10), Giving (Rom 12:8), Holiness (Rom. 5:5), Love (1 Cor. 13:13, Rom. 5:5), Peace (John 14:27), Joy (John 15:11), Valor (John 14:27), Revival or Evangelism (1 Cor. 12:28), Refreshing of the Spirit (1 Cor. 12:28), Tongues (1 Cor. 12:10), Prophecy (1 Cor. 12:10), and the Power to Cast out Evil Spirits (Mark 16:17). Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed you with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ (Eph. 1:3). Let the Lord be magnified, Who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. (Ps. 35:27)

Now, in Christ we pray, in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, who is full of grace and truth (John 1:14), that you would receive these gifts with joy and peace in believing, and that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13), and that the manifestation of the Holy Spirit is given to you for the profit of all (1 Cor. 12:7). As you receive these gifts, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you minister them to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. (1 Pet. 4:10), with great power and great grace be upon you (Acts

4:33). Surely, you, being a servant of **Jesus Christ**, are called (Rom. 1:1) to impart these gifts to your friends and your family (Rom. 1:11). In **Christ** we pray that you will use these gifts according to the grace that is given to you, and in proportion to your faith (Rom. 12:6), and according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom 1:4). The manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all. (1 Cor. 12:7) Therefore, in **Christ** we pray that you will seek to excel for the edification of the church (1 Cor. 14:12), serving in the power of the Spirit (Rom. 7:6), a life-giving spirit (1 Cor. 15:45). We make request on your behalf that God would grant you to be sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit (2 Cor. 3:6), for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life. (2 Cor. 3:6) Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. (2 Cor. 9:10-11) Lift up your heads, O you gates; and be lifted up, you everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates; even lift them up, you everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah (Ps. 24:7-10)

You did not choose the Lord, but He chose you, and ordained you, that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in **Jesus'** name He may give you. (John 15:16) In **Christ** we ask the Father, in the name of His beloved son (Matt. 3:17), **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great High Priest over the house of God (Heb. 10:21), that He raise you and your family up for Himself as faithful priests, that shall do according to that which is in His heart and in His mind: and He will build you and your family a sure house; and that you and your people shall walk before Him anointed forever. (1 Sam. 2:35) As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22), we declare that the Spirit of the Lord God is upon you and your family; because the Lord has anointed you to preach good tidings to the poor; to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; to console those who mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of

praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified. (Is. 61:1-3) Our God is able to make all grace abound toward you and your family, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, at all times, in all that you do, that you and your people will have an abundance of grace for every good work. (2 Cor. 9:8) And these signs shall follow you and your family who believes: in Jesus' name you shall cast out demons; you shall speak with new tongues; you shall take up serpents; and if you drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt you; you shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. (Mark 16:17-18) Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart: wait, I say, on the Lord! (Ps. 27:14) The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth, and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everyone says, "Glory!" The Lord sat enthroned at the Flood, and the Lord sits as King forever. The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace. (Ps. 29:9-11)

According to the will of our God and Father (Rom. 8:27, Gal. 1:4, 1 Pet. 4:19), in Christ we ask the Father, He who remembers His covenant forever (Ps. 105:8), He who remembers His holy promise (Ps. 105:42), in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), that He fulfills His word in you (Rom. 8:4, Matt. 5:17). In Christ we ask these things by the blood of Jesus, the precious lamb sacrificed (1 Pet. 1:19) so that you and your family could be all that His word declares that you are. Your kingdom come. Your will, O God, be done. (Matt. 6:10). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57). In Jesus' name and by His authority, abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22), we declare it done. Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, which You have prepared for those who trust in You in the presence of the sons of men! (Ps. 31:19)

As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) the time and the earth by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be

destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you, your house, and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints (you) to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and we pray with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), for no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 3:11), in Christ we ask our Father in heaven believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). As a vessel of ministry (Heb. 9:21), we continue to petition (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9) for it is written: "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I

will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it. You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all our petitions. (Ps. 20:5) For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
