-Nevada had a 358-255 yard edge but lost 17-14 to Colorado St.
-East Carolina had a 419-391 yard edge but lost 24-9 to Tulane.
-Texas Tech had a 527-434 yard edge but lost 41-31 to Oklahoma St.
-Northern Illinois had a 424-349 yard edge but lost 52-32 to Toledo. NIU was -4 in TO's and allowed a pair of "Pick 6's".
-FIU had a 409-402 yard edge but were -3 in TO's in a 33-12 loss to Connecticut.
-New Mexico had a 319-304 yard edge but were -3 in TO's in a 27-14 loss to Wyoming.
-UTEP had a 501-380 yard edge vs Louisiana Tech in a 41-31 loss.
-Central Michigan had a 340-250 yard edge vs Ball St but lost 17-16.

Bad Beats

-Wyoming got a "Pick 6" with 1:08 left to put the game over the 37 total vs New Mexico. That's back-to-back weeks New Mexico QB's have thrown "Pick 6's" in the final moments to put games OVER the total.
-Ole Miss (-17) scored a TD with :18 left to cover at Vanderbilt 52-28.
-It was a double-whammy for Stanford money-line and UNDER 53 bettors as Oregon St got a 56-yard TD pass with :18 left to pull out a 28-27 win.
-Memphis (-1.5) led Houston 32-19 with under 4 minutes left. Houston converted a 4th&11 and got a 4th&9 and got a TD with 1:17 left. The Cougars recovered the onside kick and scored another TD with :18 left to pull off the 33-32 stunner.

-Nick Saban told reporters on Monday that he's hopeful quarterback Bryce Young will be ready to play Saturday at Tennessee.
-Arkansas HC Sam Pittman said KJ Jefferson has been cleared and will have a full, normal week of practice ahead of BYU.
-BYU QB Jaren Hall is not at full strength but is expected to play this week.
-Colorado St QB Clay Millen is questionable vs Utah St.
-Connecticut RB Devontae Houston is out vs Ball St.
-Florida St RB Treshawn Ward won't require surgery and is ? vs Clemson.
-Fresno State QB Logan Fife will start again this week.
-Illinois QB Tommy DeVito is questionable vs Minnesota.
-Kansas HC Lance Leipold said QB Jalon Daniels did not practice Tuesday and is probably "doubtful" for Saturday. Jason Bean looks like he will get the start.
-Kentucky OC Rich Scangarello says QB Will Levis is still day to day, but he practiced Tuesday and is trending in the right direction.
-Liberty HC Hugh Freeze said that Liberty QB Kaidon Salter had surgery on Friday and that he doesn't "really have a time frame" for his return.
-Minnesota HC PJ Fleck said Monday he expects star running back Mo Ibrahim to play against Illinois on Saturday.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, October 12th

MARSHALL 29 UL-Lafayette 19. After pulling the shocking upset of Notre Dame, Marshall has failed to cover their last three games. Meanwhile, ULL will be without QB Chandler Fields for this game (Ben Wooldridge barely any downgrade). Marshall is +142 ypb, ULL -43 ypg. We laid 7 on Sunday, can't bet it now.

Thursday, October 13th

Baylor 30 WEST VIRGINIA 27. WVU's leading rusher CJ Donaldson (6.9 ypc) is out for this game but Tony Mathis actually has more carries this year. Baylor is +1.5 ypp (No. 22) on the season but WVU is +123 ypg (No. 21) despite playing 4 of 5 games vs Power 5 teams. We lean OVER.

UCF 35 Temple 11. Some early week money has come in big on Temple and we are a part of it (we bet Temple +28. The Owls are better than expected this year thanks to a defense allowing just 17 ppg and 4.1 yards per play (No. 6). Quite simply, it's tough getting margin with a low total. Pass at current numbers.

Friday, October 14th

SMU 36 Navy 21. We like SMU in this one catching Navy off the big blowout upset win over Tulsa. SMU also has extra time playing last Wednesday while Navy is on the short week. SMU is +0.4 ypp while Navy is -1.1 and the Ponies have played the tougher schedule.

Utah 45 FIU 15. This is the largest away favorite by far in UTSA's decade-plus FBS history as the only other time they laid more than 2 TD's away from home came at UTEP in 2017. FIU is starting to show some life with a win over New Mexico St and they were better than the final last week (see misleading finals page 1). Lean FIU.

Saturday, October 15th

2★ Kent St (plus the points) TOLEDO 34 Kent St 28. Toledo is off a misleading blowout win over NIU where they were +4 in TO's and got a couple of defensive scores. Meanwhile, Kent St's stats aren't terrible considering they have played the much tougher schedule. We like them here anything above a TD.

Buffalo 34 MASSACHUSETTS 17. Buffalo loses to an FCS school and the market threw them in the trash. Now at 3-0 in MAC play, the Bulls are the clear-favorites to win the MAC East now. They step out of conference here vs a UMass team that did cover vs Liberty last week. We lean OVER.

Alabama 35 TENNESSEE 27. Obviously, one of the bigger games of the season so far. The main question is the health status of Alabama QB Bryce Young. Backup QB Jalen Milroe turned it over 3 times and took 4 sacks last week as the Tide nearly got upset by A&M. We expect Young to play but he won't be 100%. Tennessee has the No. 1 offense in ypg and No. 2 in ppg. Alabama has won 15 straight in the series under Saban by 26 ppg going 11-4 ATS (+5.9 ppg). We lean UNDER.

GEORGIA 49 Vanderbilt 10. Vanderbilt games are 5-1 to the OVER while Georgia games are 5-1 to the UNDER. Something has to give. We bet OVER 53.5 on Sunday and the market has agreed. Our power ratings say Georgia is the side but we haven't been over-whelmed in recent weeks.

Miami, FL 28 VIRGINIA TECH 21. Miami comes in off 3 straight losses. The Hurricanes have not played that tough of a schedule (No. 101 in Sagarin) and yet they are -0.3 in yards per play margin (No. 95). Meanwhile, this is the worst VT team in 30 years. We like the OVER as VT finally got some offense last week and their defense is gassed.

MICHIGAN 29 Penn St 22. We saw a sharp betting group take Penn St +7.5 on Monday. We haven't bet side or total. Michigan's stats are dominant at +31.7 in ppg margin (No. 3) and +3.0 in ypp margin (No. 3) but they have played a weak schedule (No. 111). Our power ratings say Michigan here but Penn St is off the bye and have the more experienced QB. Just a popcorn game for us.

MISSISSIPPI ST 27 Kentucky 23. The big question here is the status of Kentucky QB Will Levis. He did practice Tuesday and is trending in the right direction. We saw big money come in on Kentucky Wednesday morning as the line dropped from Kentucky +6.5 to +4. He's probably playing folks.

North Carolina 36 DUKE 28. Duke got the money in the first 24 hours of betting this week while there has been buy back on North Carolina. The Blue Devils were over-priced last week (according to our ratings) and lost outright to Georgia Tech. Meanwhile, NC has responded nicely after losing to ND with back-to-back conference wins. Slight lean NC.

Florida 26 LSU 24. There are a half-dozen ranked vs ranked match-ups this Saturday but this game is one of the most intriguing in our opinion. Battle of first-year coaches and the loser could end up with a 6-6/7-5 type of season which won't make the locals happy. The LSU OL is suffering a ton of injuries and will be on their 6th different starting line-up here. Meanwhile, Florida's defense hasn't been great but came up big last week. We played LSU +3 on the open just because we thought it would close Florida -2 ish. That's where the current line is.

Maryland 35 INDIANA 25. Maryland is +1.9 in ypp margin (No. 16) while Indiana is -1.1 (No. 116). After 3 straight wins, the Hoosiers have lost 3 straight and are banged up. We haven't bet the side or total.

SYRACUSE 24 NC State 20. If you are wondering why Syracuse is favored by more than a TD, NC State QB Devin Leary is very unlikely to play here. NC State is off back-to-back physical games vs Clemson and FSU while the unbeaten Orange are off a bye. We think the Orange are the right side.

BALL ST 30 Connecticut 20. Jim Mora Jr is doing a great job with the Huskies off back-to-back wins. They are extremely banged up at the offensive skill positions though. Ball St has surprised us off back-to-back outright upsets. Lean OVER.

Central Michigan 36 AKRON 22. We bet Central Michigan -13 on the openers. They are +18 ypg on the season despite playing teams like Oklahoma St, Penn St, Toledo and South Alabama who are all at the top of their respective conferences. Akron is -2.3 in ypp margin (No. 129) while playing a weaker schedule than CMU.

PURDUE 35 Nebraska 23. We circled Purdue as a team to "bet on" this week as we wanted to fade Nebraska off back-to-back wins vs lowly Indiana and Rutgers. However, this line is a little steep at the current numbers. Pass.

Clemson 29 FLORIDA ST 24. A lot of you might be surprised at how short this spread is. However note that Florida St has played the tougher schedule (according to Sagarin) and the Seminoles are +2.2 in ypp margin (No. 13) and +140 ypg (No. 16) while Clemson is +1.3 ypp and +106 ypg. What is FSU QB Jordan Travis' mind-set after throwing two bad INT's late last week and costing the Noles the win? Despite our power ratings say this "3.5" line is right, we lean Clemson who is healthier on defense now.

EAST CAROLINA 31 Memphis 25. How does Memphis respond after blowing the Houston game in the final moments last week (see Bad Beats on page 1)? ECU is off a misleading loss to Tulane. ECU is +104 ypg and +0.9 in ypp margin while Memphis is -3 ypg and +0.1 in ypp. We think ECU is the right side.

Tulane 33 SOUTH FLORIDA 22. We cashed on these pages with USF last week as they nearly pulled the outright upset as huge underdogs in Cincy but we're not going back to them here. Tulane is 5-1 ATS this year covering by 7.5 ppg.

Minnesota 23 ILLINOIS 16. Minnesota -3 was one of our favorite bets we made on Sunday. First, we love the spot for them off a bye catching Illinois off back-to-back physical games vs Wisconsin and Iowa. On the injury front, Minnesota is likely to get back RB Ibrahim who missed the upset loss to Purdue while Illinois could be without 4-5 starters including QB Tommy DeVito.

Miami, Oh 27 BOWLING GREEN 21. Bowling Green games are 5-1 to the OVER this year by 14 ppg. We bet OVER on the openers and still lean that way but please check the wind forecast. The point spread is in line with our power ratings.

Eastern Michigan 33 NORTHERN ILLINOIS 31. At 1-5, we think Northern Illinois is underrated. Last week they had a misleading loss to Toledo where they were -4 in TO's and allowed two "Pick 6's". Will starting QB Rocky Lombardi return this season? Meanwhile EMU has pulled a couple of outright upsets. NIU games are 6-0 to the OVER so it should be no surprise we've seen this total steamed up.

2★ ODU (plus the points) COASTAL CAROLINA 33 Old Dominion 23. We're not big fans of this ODU team but we like the spot for them as they are coming off a bye. Meanwhile, five of Coastal's six wins this year have come by 12 points or less. They've escaped in each of the last two weeks. Anything above "10" is worth it for the dog.

James Madison 37 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 27. James Madison is 5-0 ATS covering by an average of 14.5 ppg. We've upgraded them more than any other team in our power ratings this year. They are +261 ypg (No. 3). Georgia Southern has a good offense and we've seen this total steamed up. We haven't bet side or total though.

2★ SOUTHERN MISS 30 Arkansas St 24. Simple handicap. We made the line Southern Miss -6. So Miss has played the tougher schedule (No. 58 vs No. 90 in Sagarin). Southern Miss is the better team in yards per play margin (+0.3 vs -1.3) despite playing that tougher schedule.

Arkansas 31 BYU 30. Really interesting scheduling spot here for Arkansas. The Hogs are playing their 7th straight week. Sagarin ranks their schedule as the toughest in the country so far and they are playing in elevation. However, we've seen a ton of money come in on them in this game. It's "two-fold". First, QB KJ Jefferson looks like he will be back after missing last week's game. Second, BYU QB Jarren Hall will play but he is banged up. We think Arkansas is the right side but can't recommend -1.5, when +3 was available. We do lean UNDER.

New Mexico 23 NEW MEXICO ST 17. New Mexico has won 7 of the last 9 meetings but 6 of the last 7 meetings between these two have come by single digits. New Mexico has been a bit better than the final scoreboard the last two weeks as they've thrown "Pick 6's" in the final moments in both games much to the demise of UNDER backers. We haven't bet the game yet.

California 33 COLORADO 19. Both teams come in off a bye. Colorado has an interim coach in Mike Sanford. The Buffs' futility this season knows no depths. They are dead last in ppg margin (-29.8), dead last in ypp margin (-230.6) and dead last in yards per play margin (-3.0). Most importantly, they are also 0-5 ATS -10.0 ppg. Pass on the side, but we do lean OVER here.

UTAH 32 USC 29. We thought this would be one of the biggest games of the Pac-12 season in the summer. USC has certainly lived up to their end of the deal with an unbeaten record. Meanwhile, Utah has disappointed big time with a pair of upset losses including last week on these pages. USC's offense has kind of hit the wall a little bit the last 3 weeks but their defense has stepped up. Meanwhile, Utah has shockingly not controlled the line of scrimmage in their two big games vs Florida and UCLA. Huge difference of opinion in the summer on this game. We bet USC +9 and Utah +3 (not a typo). Right now we prefer UNDER.

OREGON ST 29 Washington St 23. Both teams a bit banged up as Washington St will be missing their leading rusher and a starting WR while Oregon St QB Chance Nolan is questionable (missed last week). The two have played similar strengths of schedule and yet Oregon St is +1.0 in ypp while Washington St is +0.5. We bet Oregon St -2.5 and still would take them at -3.5.

WASHINGTON 42 Arizona 28. Tough laying points with this Washington defense right now as the Huskies were outright upset last week. The total opened 66.5 and is now 73. We're in the middle and would lean Arizona at anything above "14".

San Jose St 27 FRESNO ST 20. For the 4th week in a row, San Jose St has taken as much steam as any team in the market. The Spartans have covered each of their last 4 games by double-digits. They're also taking on a Fresno St team that is 0-5 ATS failing to cover by 14.5 ppg. Fresno QB Jake Haener is out again. We laid -4 on the open but can't recommend it now.

TROY 32 Texas St 16. Troy is a team to keep an eye on. They are 5-0 ATS this year vs FBS teams and we've seen them "bet on" in the market place by syndicates multiple weeks. They're catching Texas St off the big outright upset over Appalachian St last week. We didn't bet side or total here.

OLE MISS 34 Auburn 20. Auburn is 1-5 ATS failing to cover by 8.6 ppg this season and we wonder how many more weeks can Bryan Harsin hang on to his job. Meanwhile, Ole Miss is in the Top 10 of ppg margin (+25.2), ypg margin (+160) and yards per play margin (+2.4). Another game we haven't gotten to the window yet.

SOUTH ALABAMA 35 UL-Monroe 19. South Alabama has been very impressive this year at 4-1 ATS and they are coming off a bye. However, ULM has been better than expected and could've pulled the outright upset over Coastal last week. We took ULM +18 on the open.

OKLAHOMA 36 Kansas 26. Oklahoma has failed to cover the spread by a combined 98.5 points the last 3 weeks. According to Bill Connelly, that is the 5th largest total in any 3-game stretch for any team in CFB the last 30 years! And yet, here are the Sooners laying 9 to a Top 20 Kansas team. Why you may ask? Well, Dillon Gabriel should be back at QB for Oklahoma. Also Kansas QB Jalon Daniels is most likely out. We bet UNDER 65 on Sunday.

TCU 36 Oklahoma St 34. Yet another ranked on ranked match-up here. We weren't a fan of either team's performance last week in wins. Oklahoma St has been out-gained in each of the last two weeks. TCU allowed the Kansas backup QB to go up and down the field on them. We did bet Oklahoma S +3.5 but note we've seen some money come in on TCU in the last 24 hours. We lean OVER.

2★ Iowa St (plus the points) TEXAS 31 Iowa St 17. Texas is back! No for real, we mean it this time. We have Texas No. 6 in our power ratings after they crushed Oklahoma 49-0. The problem here is that they have a road trip to Oklahoma St on deck and this is a sandwich spot. It's an 11am local start and you're laying a big number vs an Iowa St team that allows just 14 ppg on defense. Iowa St has won 3 straight vs Texas but we just need them to cover here.

2★ WESTERN MICHIGAN 32 Ohio 28. We don't understand all the love for Ohio here. We will take Western Michigan who allows 1.2 yards per play less, 176 ypg less and 10 ppg less than Ohio does and that's with playing a tougher schedule. Defensive home underdogs are a staple for us on these pages.

Wisconsin 29 MICHIGAN ST 20. Wisconsin was one of our favorite bets we made on the openers when we laid 5 and gave them out to our VIP subs. Now that it has crossed through a key "7" we don't like it as much. Obviously, we think there's been a fundamental change with Jim Leonhard as coach as they hammered North-western last week. We think he gets the permanent gig if he does well and we expect them to further MSU's woes.

Western Kentucky 35 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 30. We're a little surprised to see all the WKU love here. The Hilltoppers are No. 15 in ypp margin at +2.0 while Middle is -0.6. Still, it's tough laying more than a TD vs a high-powered MT attack. **UAB 42 Charlotte 20.** UAB has taken money here and we were a bit surprised when breaking down the stats to see the Blazers No. 7 in the country in yards per play margin at +2.5. Considering they have two upset losses already maybe this team is a bit under-valued. We're just not that interested in this game.

NORTH TEXAS 37 Louisiana Tech 30. North Texas is off a bye and while we cashed with Louisiana Tech last week on these pages, they were outgained by more than 100 yards. North Texas is the better team statistically but LT has played the tougher schedule. We didn't bet the game.

FLORIDAATLANTIC 33 Rice 27. Rice games are 5-0 to the OVER this year and we're surprised to see some UNDER money show as we bet OVER 55. FAU is No. 21 in the country in plays per game. Safe to say, we like OVER.

Nevada 29 HAWAII 22. Hawaii got steamed against big time last week at San Diego St and the Warriors nearly pulled the outright upset as huge underdogs. Still, they are No. 130 in the country in ppg margin and yards per play margin. Nevada is a little bit better at No. 108 in ppg margin and No. 124 in ypp margin. Typically, we don't like laying points on the road with bad teams but we bet Nevada -4 on Sunday expecting them to take money and that's been the case.

Utah St 29 COLORADO ST 19. Watching the Utah St/BYU game from a couple weeks ago, it looked like the light bulb had finally come on for Utah St even with backup QB Cooper Legas. Last week they pulled the outright upset over Air Force. This week they took heavy steam vs a Colorado St that is No. 130 in ypp margin (-158.6). We bet UNDER 54 on the open but that is long gone.

NOTRE DAME 36 Stanford 20. We like the OVER here. ND's offense has come alive the last two weeks with 576 yards vs North Carolina and 496 yards vs BYU. They would have more points but they fumbled at the goal line vs NC and had 3 trips inside the BYU 10-yard line result in just 6 points. Meanwhile, Stanford can have success in the pass game.

Air Force 31 UNLV 21. UNLV QB Doug Brumfield was not listed on this week's depth chart. We originally bet UNLV +10 but then got off that position with the QB news. Backup Cameron Friel has plenty of experience but Brumfield has played well this year. Meanwhile, Air Force has been a double-digit favorite in every game but somehow have lost a pair of games. We lean OVER.

Week 7 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 21-17-1.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Western Michigan +1.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Thursday, October 13th

CHICAGO 20 Washington 19. A market influencer gave out Washington on Wednesday morning and we saw the line go to pick. Washington should've won last week with 385-241 yard and 6.6-3.9 yards per play edges. However, we don't agree with the move. The two teams have played similar strengths of schedules and Chicago is -0.4 in ypp margin while Washington is -0.6. On top of that, Rivera threw Carson Wentz under the bus. The Commanders have failed to cover in 4 straight games.

Sunday, October 16th

Tampa Bay 25 PITTSBURGH 18. Shame on us for falling in the "history" trap last week with Pittsburgh. We took them in their biggest underdog role ever and they were destroyed by Buffalo (-5.1 yards per play!). Tampa has now failed to cover in 3 straight games (all at home) but last week did have 420-261 yard and 5.6-4.3 yards per play edges. Maybe going on the road will help them get away from some distractions. Tampa is +0.6 in ypp while Pittsburgh is -1.1 (No. 31). We prefer Tampa in a teaser here.

New Orleans 23 CINCINNATI 22. Back-to-back road trips for Cincy here while New Orleans is playing back-to-back at home. Both teams are 2-3 and can ill afford losses if they want to make the playoffs. Cincy is -0.4 in ypp margin, New Orleans is +0.5. Yet, we've seen a ton of money on Cincinnati in the market. Regardless of who plays QB for them, give us New Orleans especially in a teaser up through key numbers of 3 and 7. Totals' players note Cincy games are 5-0 to the UNDER this year but we're not recommending that here.

INDIANAPOLIS 22 Jacksonville 19. Jacksonville had a misleading final last week as they had a 422-248 yard edge including 5.8-4.4 in ypp but lost outright to Houston as 7-point dogs. Meanwhile, Indianapolis arguably saved their season with a win over Denver in that brutal Thursday night game. Jacksonville shocked Indy in the earlier meeting 24-0. However, we lean Indy in the rematch. Totals players note that Indy games are 5-0 to the UNDER this year.

2★ NEW ENGLAND 23 Cleveland 22. We won on these pages easily with New England last week in their 29-0 demolition of the Lions. That's the second straight week we've found value on them. The Patriots have played a tougher schedule than Cleveland and statistically are better at +0.3 in ypp while the Browns are -0.3. We will take the 3 points even if we have to lay the extra juice. For the 3rd straight week, the Pats are a best bet no matter who starts at QB for them.

GREEN BAY 27 N.Y. Jets 19. We still can't believe the Packers blew that big lead last week in London just crushing our teasers and ruining our whole Sunday. Green Bay was the more talented team but the Giants looked like the better coached team. Now the Pack are laying 7 to the other team from New York this is also playing with confidence. Although it should be noted the Jets blowout win over Miami came against a 3rd string QB a majority of the game. Early week money has come in on the Jets but we lean Green Bay.

Baltimore 25 N.Y. GIANTS 20. Kudos to the Giants for getting to 4-1 on the season. If you watched the second half last week vs Green Bay, they looked like the much better coached team under Daboll. Still, the stats say this is an average team at best (-0.2 in ypp vs a below-average schedule). They are playing a Baltimore team that got by on SNF vs Cincinnati thanks to their Hall of Fame kicker but didn't get the cover. We circled this game as a possible best bet wanting to fade the Giants off the London trip but the market is all over it.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Minnesota 24 MIAMI 21. Breaking just about an hour ago on Wednesday is that it looks like Skylar Thompson will get the start here for Miami with Teddy Bridgewater and Tua Tagovailoa out in concussion protocol. We wanted to take Miami if Teddy were to get cleared. Minnesota is overrated. The Vikings have played the No. 28 schedule and are -0.5 in ypp margin despite a 4-1 SU record. The Vikings have actually failed to cover in 4 straight games.

San Francisco 25 ATLANTA 19. The Falcons are 5-0 ATS. Safe to say, they have greatly exceeded expectations. However, they will be up against here vs a San Francisco team that is more dominant than their 3-2 record indicates. They are No. 1 in the NFL in defensive ypp and No. 2 in ypp margin. They are notably staying in Greenbrier, a resort in West Virginia. This is the fourth time since Shanahan was hired in 2017 that the 49ers have practiced off-site to stay sharp without a time zone-induced listlessness. The results have been impressive with the 49ers going 7-1 SU in those games.

2★ Carolina (plus the points) L.A. RAMS 25 Carolina 17. Matt Rhule has finally been fired in Carolina and Steve Wilks is the interim. PJ Walker will get the start. As bad as Carolina has been they are -0.4 in ypp margin while the Rams are -0.6. How can you lay double-digits with this Rams offense right now? L.A. is dead last in the NFL averaging just 4.8 yards per play. They continue to have huge issues with first-down play-calling and their OL is a mess.

Arizona 26 SEATTLE 25. Despite their defensive woes as they rank dead-last in the NFL in yards per play (6.6), the Seahawks have more than made up for it on the offensive side ranking No. 2 averaging 6.6 yards per play. Meanwhile, Arizona is -1.0 in ypp margin although the Cardinals have played better as of late (covered vs powerful Philly last week and won the yardage battle). We still lean Seattle here and despite a higher total leading to more variance, we think they are a good teaser option up to +8.5.

Buffalo 28 KANSAS CITY 27. Wow, what a match-up. A rematch of one of the better playoff games in NFL history last season with the Chiefs winning the coin toss and winning in OT. The Chiefs just barely escaped the Raiders on MNF and now face a Buffalo team that is +2.3 in ypp margin. That is +0.6 more than No. 2 San Francisco. We think the Bills are the better team and we can see them being favored here. However, we can't justify them being a full-FG favorite. We lean KC.

PHILADELPHIA 24 Dallas 18. We go from a great Sunday afternoon match-up to a great Sunday night game between the unbeaten Eagles and once-beaten Cowboys. Dallas has won and covered all 4 games this season under Cooper Rush and it looks like he will get the start again here. The real reason why Dallas has been successful though is a defense that is allowing just 4.7 yards per play (No. 5) and that defense got a TD last week. They're going to be up against it here vs a talented Philly team. We circled Philly as a possible best bet here but once again the market is all over it.

Monday, October 17th

L.A. CHARGERS 25 Denver 21. It's been a bumpy ride for Russell Wilson and the Broncos so far this season. Last week's Thursday night performance vs Indianapolis had the home Denver fans heading for the exits at the start of OT. Have you ever seen that before? Meanwhile, the Chargers held on in Cleveland to move to 3-2. We think Denver is the sharp side in this one with extra time to prep and the whole market wanting to fade them.
