


## Fray Pedro de Corpa Curso ha comenzado ya

"The Guide For Catechists" (Vatican) lists the following as some key attributes of a catechist (adapted):

- + faith that manifests itself in daily life (including weekly Mass attendance at their parish);
- + love for the Church; in union with their pastors;
- + an apostolic spirit... love for their brothers and sisters and a willingness to serve;
- + sufficient education (e.g. can follow lesson plan);
- + the respect of their parish community;
- + human, moral and basic skills, energetic and good relations with others;
- + openness to the Word, to God, to the Church, and a "missionary openness" to the world.

## Notice The New Weekly Budget Figure?



Our new fiscal year weekly budget figure for our parish's weekend offertory collections averages \$3,026 as compared to \$2,588 for the FY just ended 6/30/17. The weekly increase of \$438 over last year FY is due in great part to the needed hiring of a reliable person with expertise for book-keeping and the long overdue painting of the exterior of the church and hall (\$8,700). The relatively small \$438 figure would have been higher were it not for successful measures taken last year and before to decrease the cost of utilities (\$7,000), household expenses (\$7,000), and office expenses (\$2,800). ## Clarifying Notes About An Annulment

"There is always some confusion and misunderstandings regarding the annulment process of the Roman Catholic Church.



It is sometimes incorrectly assumed that the marriages of baptized non-Catholics are not recognized by the Catholic Church as valid unions. These marriages are in fact recognized by the Catholic Church, and declaration of nullity ("Annulment") is necessary before a divorced non-Catholic may be free to marry in the Catholic Church.

Another source of confusion regarding the work of the (Church) tribunal is the fact that there are several different types of processes for the investigation of marriages. A valid Catholic marriage results from different elements:

- (1) the spouses are free to marry;
- (2) they freely exchange their consent;
- (3) in consenting to marry, they have the intention to marry for life, to be faithful to one another and be open to children; they intend the good of each other; and
- (4) their consent is given in the presence of two witnesses and before a properly authorized Priest or Deacon. Exceptions to the last requirement must be approved by church authority.


The defectiveness of any of these elements could be related to a different type of process of marriage annulment." (Source: Tribunal Newsletter, Diocese of Savannah, August 2015)
