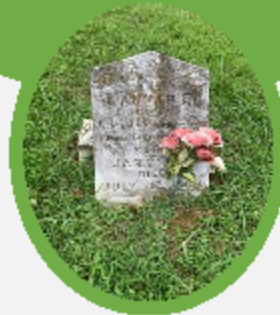


# Put A Few Things Right For the Ages
