

Passover Seder and Services This Year

This year we will hold our annual Am HaYam Passover Seder on Sunday, March 28, the second night of Passover, at 5 p.m. via Zoom. Rabbi Sacks will be officiating the seder, assisted by Maayan, our rabbinic intern. We will again do the major portions of the entire seder (both halves) and then end so that everyone can have dinner and the rest of the evening for alone time or family Zoom time.

For services this year, we will be holding services as we did last year on the second morning of Passover (Monday, March 29), but not the first. For the first day, please consider joining Congregation Beth Shalom, our sister congregation in Bermuda Dunes (near Palm Springs), with whom we have forged a good relationship over the past year.

In addition, we will have services this year on both the seventh and eighth mornings of Passover: Saturday/Shabbat, April 3 and Sunday, April 4. Yizkor will be marked during services on April 4.
