## Scripture for Today's Message

Mark 4:33-41

<sup>33</sup>Jesus used many similar stories and illustrations to teach the people as much as they could understand. <sup>34</sup>In fact, in his public ministry he never taught without using parables; but afterward, when he was alone with his disciples, he explained everything to them. <sup>35</sup>As evening came, Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's cross to the other side of the lake." <sup>36</sup>So they took Jesus in the boat and started out, leaving the crowds behind (although other boats followed). <sup>37</sup>But soon a fierce storm came up. High waves were breaking into the boat, and it began to fill with water. <sup>38</sup>Jesus was sleeping at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. The disciples woke him up, shouting, "Teacher, don't you care that we're going to drown?" <sup>39</sup>When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Silence! Be still!" Suddenly the wind stopped, and there was a great calm. <sup>40</sup>Then he asked them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" <sup>41</sup>The disciples were absolutely terrified. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "Even the wind and waves obey him!"

### Psalm 46:1-11

<sup>1</sup>God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. <sup>2</sup>So we will not fear when earthquakes come and the mountains crumble into the sea. <sup>3</sup>Let the oceans roar and foam. Let the mountains tremble as the waters surge! <sup>4</sup>A river brings joy to the city of our God, the sacred home of the Most High. <sup>5</sup>God dwells in that city; it cannot be destroyed. From the very break of day, God will protect it. <sup>6</sup>The nations are in chaos, and their kingdoms crumble! God's voice thunders, and the earth melts! <sup>7</sup>The LORD of Heaven's Armies is here among us; the God of Israel is our fortress. <sup>8</sup>Come, see the glorious works of the LORD: See how he brings destruction upon the world. <sup>9</sup>He causes wars to end throughout the earth. He breaks the bow and snaps the spear; he burns the shields with fire. <sup>10</sup>"Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world." <sup>11</sup>The LORD of Heaven's Armies is here among us; the God of Israel is our fortress.
