Elections are scheduled to take place at the 2017 Annual MASSB Conference on October 27th as part of the annual business meeting. County Advisory Committee members can nominate themselves or be nominated by another Committee member. Positions are two year terms which will begin upon election at the close of the annual meeting.

Executive Committee Officer Descriptions¹

Chairperson

MASSB Chief Executive Officer—presides over all meetings of the organization and the Executive Committee and performs the duties which ordinarily pertain to the office of the Chairperson.

Vice Chairperson

In the absence of the Chairperson, performs the duties which ordinarily pertain to the office of the Chairperson and serves as the Chairperson of any Legislative Committee that the organization's members or officers may appoint.

Treasurer

Responsible for the collection of custody of all organizational funds. Notifies each local Committee that annual dues are due. Prepares and presents a written report at each regular meeting and the annual conference meeting, or as required by the Chairperson. The Treasurer is to be the custodian of the organization's funds and financial records and perform such other duties as pertain to the Treasurer.

Nominations should include a resume and short statement of interest if submitting in advance of the conference and should be forwarded to Mark Poerio via e-mail at mpoerio@yahoo.com. Nominations will also be accepted on the floor of the conference during the annual business meeting on Friday, October 27th. Nominees should be prepared to speak briefly to the membership at the conference about their desire to serve on the MASSB Executive Committee.
