

Dear Mr. Baez,

Thank you for contacting the Office of the Governor, Consumer Health Assistance with your request for assistance with your workers compensation case. As you are aware, per the letter of March 10, 2006, your lower back is not compensable to the knee claim. This was outlined by Appeals Officer Paul Lychuk, Esquire on February 12, 2002.

After the meeting on March 24<sup>th</sup>, Ms. Rosalin and I discussed your case at great length. The only option that is available to you is to request reopening for the right knee if there is a worsening condition. We advised you that you need to submit the request in writing. Should a physician send a report without your request, the report will be filed and no determination will be made. Secondly, if the report focuses primarily on the back, as did Dr. Vater's reporting, S & C Claims does not have to render a determination in light of the 2/12/02 Appeals Officer's Decision and Order. We also discussed the possible need for an MRI and an evaluation of your knee to determine if there is a worsening condition. Listed below are some resources available to you in an effort to get the evaluation and MRI as previously stated.

You will have to contact them and apply for eligibility under their requirements.

**PLEA FROM MR. ATILANO BAEZ TO MR. GOVERNOR. KENNY C. GUINN**

Honorable Mr.Governor,

ON SEPTEMBER. 11, 2000 I had a work-related accident. Due to this accident I have become incapacitated. When I could no longer perform the duties of my job I was fired from my position. I was, and still am to this day, under prescription medication and requiring the care of medical professionals. I took my claim to the INDUSTRIAL DIVISION RELATION INSURANCE. Mrs. Luisa Carpanelli did the investigation on my case and discovered that my dismissal from my job was unjustified. It was ordered for my rights to be reestablished, of which still to this day has not been done, because of the solicitation from Attorney Daniel L. Schwarts. I am enclosing a copy of the letter from the Attorney. I have been in search for the past six years for somebody that can help me bring about justice to my situation and to seek the medical attention necessary for me to recover from the very serious consequences of this accident. I do not wish upon anybody the excruciating physical and emotional pain, along with the family problems, of the past ; **5. years** .

I sent a letter to Senator Harry Reid requesting his help. He than sent two letters to the Director of Constituent Services, Ms. Brantley. They responded after nine months that they were not the responsible party for my case. They advised me to seek the help of the Consumer Health Assistance. I went to this office with Victor Espinosa, Saul Guisar and Samuel Meza on March 24, 2006. Their response was negative and denying the present evidence and laws saying that they did not apply and I was misinterpreting them. This was said on the opinion of Dr. Thomas L. Vater and Redentor Villanueva. he referred to the medical results of the following doctors as being a bunch of **bull shit**, in respect of the opinions in the letters: Dr. J. Grondel; Dr. Ron M. Cheney; Dr. Michael W. Barney; Dr. Gregory T. Bigler; Dr. J. Latourette; Dr. Jauswinder S. Grover; Dr. Michael J. Mckenna; Dr. Lydia O'Connor; Dr. Quan Hadoung; Dr. Maureen E. Mackey; Dr. Dong S. Cho. That we are presenting to you. Isn't this very discriminating, in using this class of expression when looking for assistance? In the office of the Honorable Mr. Governor, Kenny Guinn.

For the above mentioned reasons I request, for you Sir, to **please review my case**. I plead for your support to see how my case has been tossed aside and what a lack of attention my case has received, as well as the lack of interest of these people for me to recover from the very serious injuries of which I suffered than, and have been suffering since. I do not have any other recourse, as I cannot afford the medical attention of Orthopedic Professionals. All I ask is that I return to the way my life was before; the normal life of a hard-working human being dedicated to caring for his family.

Dear Mr. Baez:

This letter is in follow-up to our conversation today through your interpreter, Karla. The issues we discussed today dealt with your complaint to the Division of Industrial Relations - Workers Compensation Section (DIR/WCS), the Nevada Attorney for Injured Workers (NAIW), and the Department of Administration - Hearings Division.

It was stated that your issues of modified duty and temporary total disability (TTD) were litigated at the Hearing Division. At the same time, you had filed a complaint to DIR on the same issue. The investigator had cited S & C Claims as well as Alpine Steel. The employer's attorney, Dan Schwartz, Esquire, had communicated to DIR's counsel, John Wiles, Esquire that your issues are currently in litigation and the citation lacked jurisdiction. This prompted a letter from Charles Verre, Chief Administrative Officer of DIR that stated that the citation is being rescinded due to lack of jurisdiction.

This office does not have jurisdiction over DIR, the Hearing Division, or NAIW. In our conversation you requested the Department of Business and Industry information. This agency oversees the DIR, NAIW, and the Hearings Division. Their address is:
