



As well as delivering all National Curriculum subjects, Prospect School has successful Learning Support strategies that help students to develop communication, literacy, numeracy and social skills. Students are entered for Key Stage 3 National Curriculum tests, GCSE, AEB, NVQs, BTechs, Asdan and Entry Level examinations as appropriate. In Years 10 and 11 students also have the opportunity to take part in college courses and a work experience programme. When students leave Prospect School they should be equipped with accreditation success, good key skills and the personal qualities, social skills and positive attitudes necessary for a productive, caring and happy life.

Prospect School is an anti-bullying school and we view bullying as a serious issue. Action will be taken immediately following any reports of bullying and the person responsible for bullying will be subject to consequences under our Behaviour for Learning policy, including exclusion from school. Prospect School is also a non-smoking school. This applies to all staff, pupils and visitors.

The school will:

- provide a safe, well ordered and caring environment
- have clear behaviour targets for all students
- value each student as an individual
- contact you by telephone or letter regularly to share good news
- inform you at an early stage of any concerns we may have so that you can discuss them and become involved in any matter relating to your child
- send you reports on work and behaviour regularly, and invite you to discuss your child's progress at a parent's consultation event
- be available, by appointment, to discuss your child's progress or concerns
- provide opportunities for you to express your views on school issues
- have a clearly stated, published Behaviour Policy detailing expectations, rewards and sanctions
- make every effort to ensure that school policies are understood and followed by all staff, students and parents
- attempt to contact you by telephone if your son is ill, needs to be sent home or has run away from school

As a parent or carer of: I will:

- support my child's learning
- ensure that my child takes any prescribed medications regularly which support their behaviour and learning in school
- encourage my child to complete any homework set
- encourage my child to read and listen to him read if appropriate
- help the school in maintaining high standards of behaviour by supporting the school's Behaviour Policy
- ensure regular attendance and make sure that my child is on time for either the taxi or school transport if applicable
- ensure my child has had a good night's sleep, has eaten breakfast, is dressed in uniform and ready for the school day
- contact the school in advance if there are any problems at home which might affect my child's performance or behaviour at school
- ensure my child has what he/she needs to take part in all activities including PE
- make sure that all emergency telephone numbers are kept updated and to be available to answer calls made by the school at all times when pupils are on site
- make arrangements for the student to be sent to the following addresses if they need to be sent home from school for any reason including a behaviour difficulty; **if no one is available at these addresses we accept that he may be sent home to the address unsupervised**
- understand that if my son leaves the school site that will mark the end of his school day
- ensure that my son does not attend the school site during periods of exclusion or at times which are not on his timetabled provision
