***ROTH GRABS FIRST TOUR TITLE IN THRILLER***

**ROTH BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION**

Corey Roth stamped his name as a GISBT champion at the 30th Anniversary season opener. The 2-hander from Coralville, Iowa charged into the Winner's Circle with a flawless 227 in the position round, and in the process, he held off a pack of impressive contenders.

The eventual champ trailed red-hot Jayson Miner by just 3 pins heading into the match play finals, and once the finals began, Roth continued his consistent shotmaking. His 258 in game #7 pushed him into 2nd place heading into the position round, and his 227-174 of Miner gave him his first GISBT championship. Prior to this month's event, Roth had appeared in 3 match play finals, with his best showing a 5th place finish in this past February's event in Moline, Illinois.

**ROTH IS BOY'S 125th CHAMPION IN TOUR HISTORY**

Roth became the 125th GISBT champion in 285 tour events. He also became the 4th consecutive first-time winner, dating back to February of last season. Besides Roth, the other recent first time champions were William Jones (February 2021), Luis Lugo (March 2021), Jayson Miner (August 2021 Tournament of Champions). The champion averaged 214.87 for his 16 games, and he was rewarded with a \$450 scholarship for the victory. Congratulations, Corey!

### **COLLINS NABS RUNNER-UP IN TOUR DEBUT**

Joshua Collins enjoyed a tremendous tour debut this month. Competing in his first GISBT event, the lanky left-handed native of Fortson, Georgia earned a \$325 payday by virtue of his runner-up finish. Collins put on a late charge in qualifying by finishing with a big 257 that earned him the 8th and final spot in the boy's match play field. Collins then averaged 215.37 for his 8 matches, and also posted the best record, with 5½ wins against just 2½ losses, and that combination allowed him to charge from 8th place into the runner-up spot, coming up just 15 pins short of victory.

### **FIELD OF 76 KICK OF 30th ANNIVERSARY SEASON**

A field of 76 competitors (54 boys and 22 girls) competed in the first event of the 2021-2022 GISBT season. This marks the 30th Anniversary season of our tour, which began in August 1992. The event was contested on the challenging 37-foot Alcatraz lane pattern. There were 28 players making their GISBT debut. Welcome to all of our new and returning players, and thanks for continuing the GISBT tradition!

### **MINER CAPS OFF MEMORABLE WEEKEND WITH 3rd PLACE SHOWING**

Jayson Miner enjoyed the finest weekend of his career this month. The right-hander from Silvis, Illinois captured Saturday's Tournament of Champions for his first tour title, and at Sunday's season opener, he put himself in prime position to make it two in a row. He held the lead heading into the position round, but suffered a 227-174 defeat at the hands of the eventual champion; as a result of the loss, he dropped into 3rd place. Still, he was consoled with a \$250 scholarship for his day's work. This was the 12th match play finals appearance of his career.

### **ERICKSON CAPS FINE WEEKEND WITH 4th PLACE FINISH**

Isaac Erickson was this month's 4th place finisher; he came away with a \$200 scholarship. Erickson, from Lititz, Pennsylvania, qualified for his 3rd consecutive match play finals, and his 4th overall. On Saturday, the talented right-hander finished runner-up in the Tournament of Champions, falling just 1 strike short of his first tour title.

### **ABOUD TAKES 5th**

Justin Aboud kept his sharp weekend form going. After finishing in 3rd place in Saturday's Tournament of Champions, he came right back with a 5th place showing in the season opener; he took home a \$225 scholarship as a result of his efforts. The San Jose, California native has competed in just 4 GISBT events in his young career, but has qualified for the match play finals all 4 times.

### **GREIM 6th IN TOUR DEBUT**

Zach Greim enjoyed a successful tour debut this month. The 18 year-old 2-hander from Poway, California finished 6th, earning a \$175 scholarship for his day's work.

### ZILK TAKES 7th

Josh Zilk continued to make a name for himself on tour with another strong performance. The versatile right-hander from Virginia Beach took home a \$150 scholarship by virtue of his 7th place finish.

### BIANCHI 8th IN FINALS DEBUT

Jacob Bianchi enjoyed a breakthrough performance at the season opener. The smooth-stroking right-hander from Altoona, Iowa finished 8th, earning a \$125 scholarship.

Bianchi had been knocking on the door, finishing 9th at the final event on last season's schedule, and then 9th again on Saturday's Tournament of Champions. This time around, he qualified 4th before slipping into 8th during the match play finals. It appears that he has a bright tour future ahead of him.

Continuing her fine form from Saturday's dominant Tournament of Champions victory, the talented right-hander from Lincoln, Nebraska racked up victory #2 at Sunday's 2020-2021 season opener.

Madison qualified 2nd, but posted the highest match play total, and a 4-2 match play ledger was enough to give her the victory.

### **BILLS & NELSON TIE FOR RUNNER-UP**

There was a dead-heat for the runner-up spot at this month's event. Marissa Bills, a right-hander from Marion, Iowa making her tour debut, and Addy Nelson, a 3-time tour winner, each garnered a \$267.50 scholarship for their second place finishes.

Bills is a promising player new to the GISBT scene, and she was in strong form throughout the event. She grabbed the lead early in qualifying, and held it for most of the day. Struggling just a bit down the stretch, she slipped into the runner-up spot.

Meanwhile, Addy Nelson of Gregory, South Dakota, used a position round victory to vault into a tie for the runner-up spot. Nelson was appearing in the 12th match play finals of her career.

### **MCARTHY PLACES 4th IN FIRST GISBT**

Another new face on the GISBT scene emerged at this month's tour stop. Katrina McCarthy, of Pelican Lake, Wisconsin made her debut a successful one as she finished in 4th place. She took home a \$200 award for her day's work.

### **MAGSAM TAKES 5th**

Keira Magsam returned to the match play finals for the 3rd time in her promising career. The powerful righty from Gretna, Nebraska earned a \$150 scholarship.

### **BREEDLOVE 6th IN FINALS DEBUT**

Lani Breedlove rounded out this month's match play finalists; she finished 6th, winning a \$125 scholarship. The right-hander from Montgomery, Illinois was one of 3 first-time finalists in this month's girls finals field.

**EXPANSION OF CASHERS THIS SEASON**

This season, the GISBT has expanded our rule in 2021-2022 to guarantee a certain number of bowlers who are under age 18 will place in the money. If there are at least 5 entries in the boys or girls division who are aged 18 or under, we will guarantee 1 will cash. If between 6 and 10 entries, 2 will cash, and at least 15 or more entries, 3 will cash.

In this month's event, there were 16 boys and 7 girls who were under age 18. Thus, in the boy's division, Jacob Bianchi, who made the boy's match play finals, cashed, and we paid 2 additional cashers as well. Those bowlers were Josh Prowse (\$65) and Ethan Zieglowsky (\$60). In the girl's division, 3 of our 6 match play finalists were under age 18, so no additional prizes were awarded in that category.
