

CBD AND DRUG TESTING

It is unlikely that a UDS (Urine Drug Screen) would show positive for THC with a patient taking pure isolate CBD. On the other hand, Full-Spectrum CBD products *may* contain trace amounts of THC (<0.3%) and are therefore more likely to test positive in a UDS. The only way to be completely safe would be to stop all usage of any Isolate or Full Spectrum substances prior to your scheduled screening.

Still, this is not a promise that your screening will come back negative, but it is not a bad idea to stop usage at least ten days (if not longer) before a urine test, if possible.

WHICH CBD PRODUCT IS SAFEST?

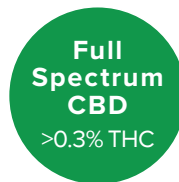
It is recommended to **STOP** the use of any and all CBD products prior to taking a drug screening.



THE NUMBERS MATTER :



has less chance of resulting in a positive drug test than:



Even this trace amount of THC could result in a **positive** drug screening.

*The chances of failing a drug test go up with higher levels of THC.



IS CBD LEGAL?

Thanks to the Agricultural Act of 2014 (US Farm Bill), it is legal to cultivate Industrial Hemp in 33 states.

Some states have different rules regarding CBD legality. For the most up-to-date information, check your local or state-wide measures about CBD products.
