1906 - 1987

Benjamin V. Dominiak, 81 of Lake Township, passed away Wednesday, Oct. 7 at University Hospital, Ann Arbor, following a long illness.

He was born May 18, 1906 in Painesdale, son of the late Ignatious and Mary (Wauzyniak) Dominiak. On June 6, 1931, he was united in marriage to Geraldine Davey in Detroit.
