## **MGA Executive Committee Meeting Minutes**

## **Agenda Items:**

- 2) Committee Reports:

Treasurers: Tony reviewed the first cut of the budget and was thanked for a job well done. The bottom line was the budget had a deficit of \$151, but with \$1,033 left in our account from last year we are \$882 ahead.

Tournament: No report

Handicap: Bruce reported that he and Bill Ferguson are going to a handicap seminar in November.

Membership: Dave reported that there are 81 members so far this year. We had budgeted for 150 and should reach that number by the time everyone rejoins.

Registration: Ron Dillon will be out for a few weeks due to back surgery. People have been lined up to run registration while he is out.

Dave Rowland said members that have not yet rejoined will have their names in small print on the weekly registration sheets so they can be directed to him during registration to rejoin.

Rules: Bill discussed playing the ball up or down and putting the ball out. After another long discussion, we again said the ball will be played down unless conditions warrant playing it up as stated in the MGA book.

Some of the playing the ball down rules were discussed: If the ball is on a tree root, it can be moved one club length and dropped with a one stroke penalty. If the ball is against the wall on number 3, it can be moved 2 club lengths and dropped with a one stroke penalty. Balls behind a tree can also be moved one club length and dropped for a one stroke penalty. Balls moved to the fairway in these cases will result in adding 2 strokes to the players score.

Food and Beverage: There will be a luncheon on November 7.

Tommy thanked all committee members for their support last year and for volunteering to support this year.

Tommy discussed having a head table at luncheons for officers as we once did in the past. We discussed and decided that since committee heads do their reporting from the floor a head table is not needed.
