***TL.** A home plan at Noah's House is pending approval.

***RA.** He will be maxing out on 12/11/16. The jail chaplain will be transporting him to the Cold Weather Shelter. He will need clothing/essentials and task force members offered to send donations to the jail for him to have upon release.

***CR.** He was discharged on Nov. 10, 2016.

***TC.** He will not be living with his girlfriend and plans to fight for full custody of his children.

***BR.** Considering Salvation Army in Altoona. Interested in faith-based recovery groups.
