Third grade students used code with Ozobots. Fifth graders experimented with Stop Motion Video.







It's time for Lip Sync at VPE!

Lip Sync is a long standing tradition at VPE, which invites students from grades 1–6 to form a group, choose a song, and perform in a concert in front of the other students. The performances include lip sync technique, costumes, and props/back drop. The performance will be professionally videotaped.

Below you will find the rules and criteria required to participate in this activity. **PLEASE READ** CAREFULLY!

- A parent from each group MUST attend an informational lip sync meeting on Thursday, April 11th at 1:15pm in the Teachers Lounge. At that time, you will be given the necessary forms to complete as well as the deadlines.
- A permission slip permitting the student to participate in lip sync MUST be signed and turned into the school office.
- When choosing your music, please keep in mind that it **MUST** be appropriate for a school environment with young children. Music is subject to review and offensive songs may be rejected, even if edited. If you have questions about certain lyrics, please let us know. The duration of the songs must be three minutes or less. Music and lyrics must be submitted for approval by Wednesday, May 1st. Groups with music and lyrics that have NOT been approved by this date will not be allowed to perform. This is a firm date!
- There must be at least **two** members in each group, and no adult or teacher may be allowed in a student's group.
- No gymnastics.
- No throwing things into the audience.
- No practicing is allowed on VPE's campus until after the bell rings at 2:20pm. Parents must sign in through the office before entering campus. On-campus practices are not sanctioned or supervised by the school, so parents must either be present or make arrangements for their child to be supervised while on campus.
- No practicing is allowed on VPE's campus until AFTER 3:30pm, unless you are out on the grass or black top, away from the buildings.
- The performances will start with the first graders and continue in grade order. The sixth graders will perform last, with the order chosen through a lottery system. No special accommodations or changes to the performance date/order will be made.
- This year there is only one performance. The performance date is *Tuesday, June 11th at 8:15 am*.

2019-20 School Year Pertussis (Whooping Cough) Immunization and Varicella Requirements

All 7th Grade Students will need to Provide Proof of a Pertussis Booster and 2nd Varicella vaccine.



On July 1, 2011, California Assembly Bill 354 requires that all 7th grade students entering school for the 2019-20 school year will be required to provide proof of a Tdap (Pertussis) booster. This may be met by receiving this booster on or after your child's 7th birthday.

Starting July 1 2019 all children will require

Be Safe at Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Pick Up!

It is our intention and hope that all students and families arrive safe on campus. Please, please use caution and patience in the morning and afternoon. - Clarify your pickup location with your student(s)
- Post your name visibly in the front window for front lot drive up Older siblings should meet younger siblings
- Please be courteous and DO NOT cut in front of the drive up lane if there is cars already lined up waiting
- Please DO NOT ask your child to wait off campus
- Supervised Pick Up ends at 2:35
