


QUEEN OF ALL SAINTS INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH

Our latest family of newcomers has arrived from Afghanistan, only six months after making application. The Canadian government fast tracked them to bring them to safety so quickly. We are rapidly getting them settled in a three-bedroom

housing unit in Shediac just down the street from their aunt, uncle and cousins.

We have been able to supply them with a lot of donated furniture and kitchen items but they need: a kitchen table and chairs, coffee table, flat screen tv and they would appreciate an area rug for their living room.

Through the generosity of many, we have already raised \$18,000.00. Another \$20,000 will be required to support this family for our 1-year commitment.
