- Provide professional engineering consulting on agricultural systems planning and design
- Prepare grants/loans/cost sharing application packages for eligible entities or farmers
- Conduct/organize on-site workshops, technology demonstrations at farms, tribal community centers, or county extension offices
- Promote locally produced food in Southern Arizona
