Three reminders.

- a. There is MUCHO paperwork/ISBN #s to track down/etc. to do to register for NSDA Districts. It's not hard or anything, just time-consuming. So start EARLY.
- b. Your kids' points need to be updated so you can maximize your degrees and entry size (not naming names or neomiaing names). Also make sure your kids register for their NSDA accounts in your chapters (earning a little star at the ends of their names) so you can register them.
- c. If you are sending in Congress bills/resolutions, the ones that are due 3/8, make sure you USE NSDA GUIDELINES for formatting. You can find those easily here. <http://www.congressionaldebate.org/resources/legislation-templates> Remember that Kentucky-oriented legislation for Kentucky laws or about state education don't apply to a national congress that uses NSDA rules, so don't send those in as they are not applicable.
