FAMILY FOCUSED RE-ENTRY PROGRAM

Assessments/Programming

Our Pre- Incarceration allows us to assess inmates needs and background such as education, vocational training, pre-psychological or substance abuse history to help design a plan for the post incarceration services. Inmates are continuously engaged by the DOC reentry program until released to the community. AJRR engages ex-offender within 24hrs in collaboration with the DOC reentry program to continue service and support.

While inmate is incarcerated, AJRR will provide services to the family thereby identifying high risk youths or children in the home.

AJRR will also serve as an agent to help inmate get all required documents to qualify for DOC reentry services.

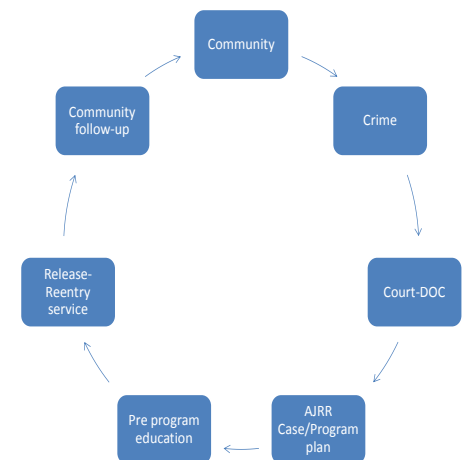

A---American: Our goal and commitment is to all American citizens and residents. Our process being holistic focuses on Veterans and Ex-offenders for the purpose of reducing recidivism

J---Justice: Our goal supports, reducing mis-labels and help regulate law violations perpetrated by repeat offenders through referral programs

R---Re-entry: Reentry is our core service to humanity. Over 2.2 million people are currently incarcerated in the US, with 97% expected to be released back to the society (about 650,000) out of which 67% are State incarcerated and 40% are federal inmates. Over 90% are re-arrested (Recidivism). AJRR serves as a continued service to support the DOC re-entry project with a focus to increase the 16% estimated success story to over 50%. AJRR strategies is a forward looking strategy focused on reducing repeated behaviors through support and reducing behavioral transference to high risk youths and children within the Veterans or Ex-offenders support system (family circle/victims). We aim for our approach to significantly impact on our school system as well as reduce recidivism

R---Rehabilitation: Our goal and commitment is to foster public safety, by creating pre and post incarceration service through sustenance training, behavioral skills training, mental health assessment services and financial to housing support.
