

# Steeplebush



This native shrub requires consistently moist soils. It makes a good low hedge or rain garden plant. Steeplebush will attract butterflies, moths, bees and other pollinators to your garden. It is a larval host for the Columbia Silkmoth. This plant has also been used medicinally.

## *Spirea tomentosa*

- Hardiness: Zone 4-7
- Size: 2-4'
- Habit: Upright mound, suckering
- Flower: Deep rose to rose purple, 3-8" long, late summer
- Culture: Sun to shade. Requires consistently moist soil.
- Uses: Low hedge, naturalizing, rain garden, wet areas, massing, deer tolerant, erosion control, bees, butterflies, insects, medicinal
