Day One

Read: Acts 1:1-2:40

- 4. What was the immediate effect upon those who received the Holy Spirit?

3. What group is specifically mentioned as being provided for?

4. How would you compare the church body today to the body we see in Acts? What's different? Why do you think that is?

The first believers lived in a state of community. They studied, ate, met needs, worshipped...etc as a part of their fellowship. What is God showing you about how He designed the body to function and your role in it? Write a prayer in response.

Day Three

Read: Acts 2:14-40, 3:1-26; Matt 3:1-12; Matt 4:17; Matt 11:20; Mark 6:11-13

- 1. What does Peter direct the people to do to be saved?
- 2. What does John the Baptist direct the people to do to be saved?
- 3. What did Jesus preach was required to be saved?
- 4. What did the disciples preach was required to be saved?

Repentance is fundamental to salvation. There is no salvation apart from repentance. John the Baptist said to "bring forth fruits in keeping with repentance". Write your own definition of repentance. Meditate on Matt 3:8 and then write a prayer in response.

Read: Acts 6:1-7:59

1. What crime was Stephen guilty of?

2. What did Stephen's sermon reveal about the people "trying" him?

3. What about his sermon would have offended the Sanhedrin?

4. What was Stephen's last thought?
