Dawson Trotman began the work among men of the Navy in San Diego before WWII - a work later dubbed "The Navigators" by the men themselves, because they learned how to use the Bible as their chart in navigating the sea of life, with Christ as their Captain. After WWII those sailors took the Gospel of Jesus to their colleges, work places and oversees as missionaries to those they battled with during the war. The Navigator ministries exploded in all the branches of the military, college campuses and churches across the Nation. Over the years the Navy has sent out men and women who were mature in Christ to develop others for service in the Kingdom of God. During the past two decades many

Navy bases have been without laborers and leaders. But, God is on the move in the Navy.

For the past year God has been speaking to us about moving out of Ft. Bliss, TX to another ministry location within the U.S. With many hours of prayer, Godly council, and direction through the Word (Ezek 47:9-12, Amos 9:11-15, Is 66:19). God has lead us to Norfolk Naval Base in Virginia. Norfolk is the world's largest naval station, supporting 75 ships and 134 aircraft and it houses the largest concentration of U.S. Naval forces. We plan to be on the ground during the Spring of 2014.

As we transition to Norfolk would you join our weekly

prayer team in asking God to send laborers out into His harvest at Norfolk (Matthew 9:37-38) to reach all the sailors at Norfolk? We hope to have 100 people on the team before we arrive there.
