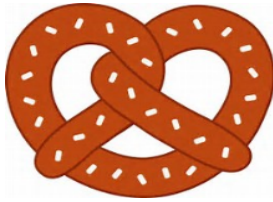


Accreditation Update- change of date!

Prayer For Holy Family School:

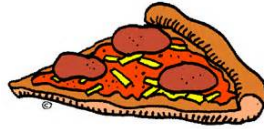
