Although "Mother Nature" threw a Grinch or two into our show, we did pretty well, considering.

Show day cash donations, non-auction sales and a small 50/50 raffle yielded a total of \$1,228. Several late donations, a donation in memory of Club member Bryan Smith by his employer and a donation of a couple hundred bucks by the Club added another \$500, pushed the total to \$1,728.

We also collected 139 toys, 1 bike and 2 extra large Teddy Bears.

We left a collection box at Handy Ace Hardware, which continued to collect more toys, adding an AMAZING 138 more to the total.

TOTAL: **280 Toys** and **\$1,728**. Not bad at all for a wet, wet show day!

The rain that was tracking north of us shifted south and the rains came, and STAYED.

We were counting on around 150 show cars, we got 40, we had to cancel our auction, cover everything we could and just wait it out. Around 1:00 pm, we had a break and gave out the awards (amazingly all the award winners stuck around).

All was not lost, as we did manage to collect 139 toys, 1 bike, 2 very large teddy bears and \$1,228 in cash. The club added another \$500 plus Handy Hardware requested the Marines leave an empty box to collect additional toys. That worked out extremely well with an additional 138 toys. Our GRAND TOTAL: 270 toys and \$1,728 in donations. Not our best, but not too "Shabby" for a wet show day! Thanks to all that donated!

Of course there are MANY thanks to pass out for this show . . . Our A-Team did an excellent job of setting up, covering everything from the rain and packing it up when we were done. They also handled the event T-shirt distribution, registration and setting up for the auction. Our retired Marines did an outstanding job, along with the Handy Hardware staff plus Mike Perry and his crew. Mike set up his grill and took care of everyone that braved the rain.
