Community wide sales

Newbies in our community recently asked about the community wide sale that was going on around the Ranch. The Ranch provides advertising in local media and places signs around the perimeter and entrances of the Ranch. Sale hours are 7 am – 1 p.m. Residents are allowed to place 1 sign in their yard.
