AED's

These are **"A**utomatic **E**xternal **D**efibrillators. There are 2 of them in the park. One is always accessible in the EAST laundromat (next to lot 107) and the other is reachable whenever the main hall is open. It is located on the wall next to the EAST door that exits onto the shuffleboard courts. If someone has collapsed, anyone can use an AED. Turn it on and it will tell you what to do. Hopefully we can have a refresher course on basic CPR next season.



HELPING HANDS CORNER


