Participation

Because we're at the retreat to learn more about our relationship with our Heavenly Father, it will also be important to grow in our relationship with each other by participating in all retreat activities. Off limits!

Kitchen food supply areas are also restricted.
Additional restricted areas may be determined by the directors.

Dating relationships

We'd rather you use this time to build up your relationship with God instead of building a romantic pursuit. Stay public and take a break from hand holding, hugging, & kissing

Electronic Devices

Because we're taking time out from the usual activities that might distract us, please leave at home any items such as cell phones, MP3 players, radios, portable game systems, etc.

Items such as tobacco, alcohol and drugs are prohibited, as campers should be receiving a spiritual high that will surpass any man-made chemical.

Medications

Please turn in a list of and all medications (prescription and over the counter) that the camper will be needing during the time at the retreat, and the nurse will make sure campers receive them at the appropriate times.
