As a Company member at Summit, your child will have the opportunity to train under award-winning choreographers, build and refine their technique, and compete in world-class regional competitions.

Being a part of a competitive team is an incredible experience. Your child will not only grow as a dancer, but will also learn valuable life skills, including teamwork, self-discipline, time management, and how to build life-long friendships.

We want everyone to feel welcome to be a part of Company; however, please understand that it is not for everyone. Being a member of a team requires a serious time commitment, as well as substantial financial investment on your part. It is very important that your child is passionate about dance and that it is his/her activity of choice. Please read through this packet of information completely. We are available to answer your questions and to address any concerns you may have.

What type of commitment is expected?

Being a member of Summit Dance Academy Company is an 11-month commitment. Classes begin in July and will continue through the beginning of June. To best support your child's accelerated training in Company, ATTENDANCE IS EXPECTED. All foreseen absences should be submitted to the office, in writing, two-weeks prior to the absence. In the case of emergency (i.e. medical issue, family emergency, etc.), please notify the office, in writing, within 48 hours of the absence. If more than three unexcused absences occur during the dance season, you may be asked to withdraw from the program. Please note that you will remain responsible for payment regardless of your child's attendance.

What is expected of team parents?

At Summit, our biggest expectation is that you support your child and their teammates. Please be timely to rehearsals and events, encourage healthy nutrition and rest, and minimize negative attitudes. Four hours of volunteer service will also be required of all parents. These hours may be fulfilled by assisting during studio-sponsored events and by helping with costuming, prop design, prop transportation, and charity event advertising. Please notify the office of your interests in volunteering with the Studio. In class, we ask that you please trust the Teachers and Directors. We are professionals, and we care about your child. Detailed expectations can be found in the Parent Code of Conduct, included in your orientation packet. Please review this information carefully and return a signed copy to the office.

How do I register for auditions?

You will be emailed a sign up. We are asking for the audition forms to be turned in by May 1 so that they can help us plan for next season. There is a \$45 audition fee due at auditions paid by cash or check.

How will I be informed of information regarding SDA Company?

A Company Band App will be used to communicate team upcoming events, along with email correspondence.

Why am I required to take Ballet?

Ballet is the foundation of all forms of dance. It engenders whole-body awareness and fine-tuned control that translates into all other forms of dance. It is through ballet training that we achieve agility, grace, presence, and quality of movement.

Can I do team if I am also doing Poms?

We offer select dances for dancers who are involved in high school poms.

There will be a flat office charge this year for solos/duets/trios to cover the office time. It will be \$125 per dancer. We clock in over 200 hours of admin time on these separate pieces.

When are team fees due?

Team Fees are split into 10 monthly payments (June-March) due the 15th of each month. Solo fees, master classes, conventions and summer session are not included in the team monthly fee. Participation fee is due May 15 and is non-refundable. The participation fee goes towards the hundreds of hours the office staff puts into the teams each year, as well as travel for our guests. We have shifted our payment plan this year to start earlier due to event times.

What is Summit's Intensive? (Required for team members)

This summer intensive is a two/three-week, full-immersion program into the contemporary arts. Dancers ages seven and older will have the opportunity to study classical and contemporary technique, as well as partnering, kinesiology, choreography, Pilates, and more! The Intensive is available to any intermediate or advanced dancer, although space is limited.

When am I ready to have a solo choreographed for competition?

Performing a solo, duo, or trio can advance your dance career. Please understand that it requires a serious time commitment and a significant financial investment on your part (in addition to Company fees and tuition). While soloists will learn their choreography in the summer/fall, they are expected to work on some aspect of it DAILY, focusing on the emotional, technical, and stamina aspects of their dances. Because soloists are representatives of Summit Dance Academy, we want to bring only the dances that have been well-rehearsed. If you are interested in having a solo/duo/trio choreographed, please fill out an application. You are required to be in two group dances for a solo.

Program Options Pro-Track

Max training! Max Commitment!

Select pieces will be listed under this training program. These dancers will be held to a higher standard. Including commitment to attendance, training, conventions, summer training, and solos. These dancers will need to take all styles including ballet, contemporary, lyrical, tap, conditioning, Acro and much more. This team will do multiple conventions and competitions. They will still do large group pieces with the Competitive teams at full group events. Events listed are examples. We are still waiting on the schedules to be released.

Competitive-Track

Dancers who want to be part of the convention and competition setting. This is for dancers who want a strong commitment, but do not want to do multiple conventions. (1 convention/multiple competitions). This program is suggested if your dancer does not want to do as many conventions. We are still waiting on the schedules to be released.

High School Poms-Track

Dancers who want to be part of team, but without a heavy commitment- time or financially. These teams do not travel for nationals or regionals. We work around their schedules.

Please make sure to take the time to talk with your dancer about their commitment levels. Please take the time as a family to financially look at your commitment level. We offer so many programs and there is not one right answer. We want to make sure it is tailored to your family and dancer's needs.

All Teams:

Please remember that attendance is mandatory in each program for classes and choreography. All absences need to be excused two weeks prior, exception of emergencies and illness. Moving forward dance placement will be adjusted according to absences. Also, if you miss choreography rehearsals you are responsible to have a private with a teaching assistant before the next set of rehearsals. This will allow for the teams to keep moving forward and progress at each rehearsal. You must be in attendance at choreography to participate in a dance.

It is imperative that dancers keep up their studio training if they are interested in college dance teams. More are more the colleges are taking competitive dancers over any other trained dancers for their teams.

Summer: 2 weeks of summer camp (1 must be Industry Intensive)


