

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and with regard to Guidelines from CDC and the ND Dept of Health, the Morton County Fair will be scaled back this year in order to help minimize the spread of COVID-19.

The decision was made out of our concern for the health and safety of our community, our attendees, exhibitors, vendors and staff.

This year:

- There will be no gate/entrance fee
- All livestock events will be in a “Show” & “Go” format this year. There will be no overnight stays for animals.
- There will be no 4-H concessions available
  - There will be several food vendors on the Fair grounds
- Open Class Poultry & Rabbit will be judged the same time as 4-H on July 30<sup>th</sup>
- All the following events will happen on Saturday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020
  - All Open Class Livestock Shows (except Poultry & Rabbit)
  - Draft Horse Pull in Rodeo Arena
  - Free Noon Meal
  - Kiddie Tractor Pull
  - Dance
- The following 4-H events are as follows:
  - July 27<sup>th</sup> & July 28<sup>th</sup>
    - Static exhibit drop off
  - July 29<sup>th</sup>
    - Static exhibit judging and display
  - July 29<sup>th</sup>
    - Horse Speed Event
  - July 30<sup>th</sup>
    - Horse Show
    - Rabbit/Poultry Show (one show in the AM, the other show in the PM)
  - July 31<sup>st</sup>
    - 4-H Remaining Livestock Shows
    - Premium Sale
