Misleading Finals

Indiana was outgained 545-484 but won in OT vs Western Kentucky. The Hoosiers only had a 11% post-game win expectancy.

Bowling Green was outgained 547-377 but upset Marshall in 3OT thanks to a +3 TO margin. The Falcons only had a 14% post-game win expectancy.

Syracuse only had a 20% post-game win expectancy but beat Purdue in the final seconds 32-29. The Orange were outgained 485-306.

Liberty outgained Wake Forest 437-346 but lost by one point thanks to a -2 TO margin. Wake only had a 37% postgame win expectancy.

Georgia Southern had a 418-413 yard edge vs UAB but were -3 in TO's.

Duquesne outgained Hawaii 364-184 but somehow lost 24-14.

The **Purdue/Syracuse** game had a total of 59.5. Syracuse led 10-9 entering the 4Q as the two teams combined for 42 4Q points. The final TD came with :07 left, a 25-yard pass that gave Syracuse the 32-29 win and put the game OVER.

Instead of taking a knee, **Tennessee** scored a TD with :59 left to beat Akron 63-6 and put the game OVER the total of 67.

Instead of taking a knee, **Central Michigan** scored a TD with 1:15 left to beat Bucknell 41-0 as 40.5-point favorites. CMU only led 7-0 at halftime and 20-0 entering the 4Q.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, September 22nd

West Virginia 27 VIRGINIA TECH 24. VT's defense continues to impress as they are allowing just 201 ypg (No. 5) and 42 rush ypg (No. 3). However, their offense continues to struggle avg just 24 ppg. WVU has played the tougher schedule (No. 48 vs No. 165 in Sagarin's SOS) and have the better QB. We bet them -2 on the openers and can't believe the market has gone the other way.

Coastal Carolina 32 GEORGIA ST 31. 3-0 team on the road vs an 0-3 team laying less than a FG. Seems easy right? Wrong. Georgia St is +20 ypg out-rushing its opponents by a 231-121 average while playing a tougher schedule than Coastal. We're waiting on a "+3" to show but we think Georgia St is the sharper side.

Friday, September 23rd

SYRACUSE 31 Virginia 21. Syracuse is 3-0 ATS with a cover margin of 13.8 ppg while Virginia is 0-3 ATS failing to cover by 9.3 ppg. Two programs heading in different directions this season. We prefer the UNDER which is 3-0 in Virginia games this season by an average of 20 ppg.

AIR FORCE 36 Nevada 13. Air Force greatly disappointed us last week losing outright as 16.5-point favorites to Wyoming. We expect them to rebound in a big way here. Meanwhile, Nevada is traveling on a short week after playing at Iowa last week. That game didn't end until 1:39am in the morning due to 4 hours of lightning delays. Slight lean OVER.

Boise St 31 UTEP 14. UTEP has been a big disappointment this season at 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 11.8 ppg. However, it's tough laying points with a Boise offense averaging just 26 ppg. We bet UNDER 49.5 on the openers.

Saturday, September 24th

2★ Baylor 24 IOWA ST 23. The unbeaten Cyclones are better than anticipated so far but we still have our doubts. We think if you change one play in the BYU game, you would have seen a 3-0 Baylor team favored here. That screams value to us.

KENTUCKY 38 Northern Illinois 15. The biggest question here is the status of NIU QB Rocky Lombardi who was injured in last week's game vs Vanderbilt. We think the current line of "25.5" reflects that he won't play here. Meanwhile, Kentucky is 3-0 ATS on the season with a defense allowing just 10 ppg and 254 ypg.

SOUTH CAROLINA 43 Charlotte 21. What a difference QB Chris Reynolds makes for Charlotte. After missing the William & Mary and Maryland games, Reynolds came back last week and threw for 5 TD passes in the upset over Georgia St as 19.5-point underdogs. We've seen a ton of money come in on the OVER here. We think it's too high. UNDER for us.

TEMPLE 26 Massachusetts 19. Tough laying more than a TD with a Temple offense averaging just 15 ppg. The Owls did out-gain Rutgers 264-201 last week. Meanwhile, UMass got steamed in the market by a sharp betting syndicate and they beat FCS Stony Brooks 20-3. We bet UMass +10.

GEORGIA 52 Kent St 7. Right now, we'd favor Georgia over Alabama. We did not expect that to be the case but the Bulldogs have made Oregon and South Carolina look like Group of 5 teams already this season. They'll name the score here.

NORTH CAROLINA 31 Notre Dame 29. We were stunned this game opened pick and moved to Notre Dame -1. The Irish don't have the weapons on offense to keep pace with a high-powered NC team. Tar Heel WR Josh Downs is likely to return and NC is off a bye. We love OVER 56.

MIAMI, FL 41 Middle Tennessee 14. Miami outplayed A&M but failed in the red zone and on special teams. The Canes are going to be down a couple of WR's for awhile. Meanwhile, MT has rebounded since week one to cover their last two games by a combined 52.5 points. Our power ratings are in line with the market. Pass.

MICHIGAN 39 Maryland 21. Michigan has played the "Little Sisters of the Poor" so far but to their credit, they've destroyed all three teams by 49 ppg while outgaining them by 304 ypg. They'll get some resistance here vs a 3-0 Maryland team. However, Michigan has won the last 6 meetings by 33.7 ppg while covering all 6 by 14.4 ppg. We bet Michigan -16 and anything under 17 is good.

NC STATE 44 Connecticut 7. Connecticut is playing a 5th straight week already and they are banged up bad at the skill positions with multiple starters out. NC State is 3-0 but we haven't been impressed. We will be looking to fade them next week at Clemson but this isn't the week to do it.

PENN ST 42 Central Michigan 17. What a difference recruiting makes! Penn St couldn't run the football last year. They averaged just 108 rush ypg. So what does James Franklin do? He signs the top RB recruit in the country in Nicholas Singleton who ran over and around Auburn last week. The Nittany Lions look like a legit Top 10 team but this line is a bit pricey. They were laying 28 points at home to Ohio two weeks ago and CMU is a better MAC team.

CENTRAL FLORIDA 37 Georgia Tech 18. Georgia Tech is 0-3 ATS already and head coach Geoff Collins will be on the way out soon. UCF crushed FAU last week and we've seen sharp betting groups lay the points here.

LOUISVILLE 37 South Florida 22. That was truly a pathetic second half effort from Louisville last week. At home, vs a backup QB and they lose to Florida St. Scott Satterfield should be feeling the heat. Meanwhile USF played their best game in years last week in a near upset of Florida. We doubt they can replicate that here.

Minnesota 27 MICHIGAN ST 26. Both teams are dealing with injuries at WR (see page 1). Minnesota is 3-0 ATS covering by 9 ppg but are taking a big step up in competition here. Michigan St was outclassed in Washington last week. We like MSU at "+3".

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

3★ Clemson 34 WAKE FOREST 24. Clemson has won 13 straight in the series including 10 in a row by at least 14 points. The reality is their defensive line is a really bad match-up for Wake's version of the RPO. Even last year when Wake had their best team in a generation and Clemson was way down, the Tigers won by 21 as 4-point favorites. We expect more of the same here. This is the game Clemson has been pointing towards while Wake should have lost to Liberty last week.

OHIO ST 38 Wisconsin 17. We bet Ohio St -16 on the openers. We still like them at the current numbers. Last week, they put on an offensive clinic notching 763 yards and 77 points vs the MAC's best defense. QB CJ Stroud already has an 11-0 TD-to-INT ratio. Meanwhile, Wisconsin doesn't have the fire-power to keep up as the Bucks have won 8 straight in the series.

LIBERTY 41 Akron 14. Akron is 0-3 ATS failing to cover by 12.7 ppg while Liberty should have upset Wake Forest last week. This has been one of the biggest line movers of the week as Liberty opened -22. We bet that but pass at the current line.

FLORIDA ST 32 Boston College 17. BC is 0-3 ATS and they are having major OL issues (ZERO returning starters). The Eagles are averaging just 48 rush ypg and have allowed 12 sacks. We did bet BC on the openers thinking FSU QB Jordan Travis might not play. This line is saying he will and it looks like we made some really bad bets. Still, this is a steep line for an FSU team.

TENNESSEE 34 Florida 25. Our records go back to 1976. Tennessee has never been more than a TD favorite vs Florida but they're laying 10.5 here. We bet against Florida each of the first 3 weeks. We had one of our best bets on these pages last week cash against them with USF. This week, we bet Florida. We think the market threw them in the trash for what was a clear letdown spot.

CINCINNATI 36 Indiana 21. Indiana is a fraudulent 3-0 team. The Hoosiers had an 11% post-game win expectancy last week in their OT win vs WKU. Another big line mover here with Cincy opening -11. We agree with the move but can't lay the current "-16.5".

EAST CAROLINA 32 Navy 17. East Carolina has been impressive so far this season at 3-0 ATS outgaining their opponents by 150 ypg. Meanwhile, Navy is 0-2 SU and ATS but the Middies do come in off a bye. We bet them "+17".

GEORGIA SOUTHERN 37 Ball St 26. We bet Georgia Southern -8 and -9 and gave out to VIP clients as one of our top plays. We've been impressed with their offense averaging 521 ypg. Last week in a flat spot after upsetting Nebraska, they were -3 in TO's and were better than the final vs UAB. They're taking on a Ball St team that benefited from playing a backup FCS QB last week.

EASTERN MICHIGAN 31 Buffalo 27. EMU is fresh off a big outright upset win over Arizona St last week as 20.5-point underdogs! Keep an eye on RB Samson Evans who incredibly ran for 258 yards! However, we like Buffalo here. At 0-3, they are in desperation mode.

3★ JMU (plus the points) APPALACHIAN ST 31 James Madison 27. Handicapping 101 says this is a great spot for James Madison off a bye vs an App St team off a 4Q thriller vs North Carolina, an outright upset over Texas A&M and last week a "Hail Mary" win with ESPN College Gameday on hand. Does the market know how to power rate JMU yet? They are 2-0 ATS covering by a combined 47 points.

Iowa 23 RUTGERS 16. Iowa games are 3-0 to the UNDER this year by an average of 22 ppg. The total is 34.5 on this game. If that holds, it will be the lowest total in the FBS in 7 years (Missouri/Vanderbilt in 2015 had a total of 34, Vandy won 10-3). Call us crazy but we lean OVER.

KANSAS 37 Duke 30. Big game here and yes we know this is CFB, not CBB. Both teams are 3-0 SU and the winner will have its sights on a bowl. Kansas has incredibly covered their last 6 games by 21 ppg. However, now they're laying more than a TD vs an unbeaten team. We bet OVER which is 3-0 in Kansas games by 20.5 ppg.

NORTHWESTERN 28 Miami, OH 21. Northwestern has played 3 games. All 3 games involved an outright upset of a double-digit favorite. The Wildcats have lost two straight in the big favorite role. You just can't lay points with them as they are 14-23-1 ATS as a home favorite the last 10 years. Pass.

OLD DOMINION 32 Arkansas St 25. We bet ODU on Sunday at -2.5. The Monarchs have taken money in the market place vs Virginia Tech and Virginia this year and were right both times. Arkansas St is improved this year but they were worse than the final last week vs Memphis (-177 yards).

Ucla 37 COLORADO 18. Colorado is 0-3 SU and 0-3 ATS failing to cover by 13 ppg. They've been outscored by 33 ppg and outgained by 207 ypg. Can you believe we bet them +22 on the openers? Remember, we bet numbers, not team. It's more of a "play against" this UCLA team that has played one of the weakest schedules in the country. The Bruins could have lost outright to South Alabama last week.

BYU 38 Wyoming 13. Some disparate results from last week say the value is on BYU in this game. The Cougars were blown out in Oregon while Wyoming pulled the shocker over Air Force. Tough laying a big number with a low total, but we like the Cougars to bounce back.

NEW MEXICO ST 29 Hawaii 26. Tough laying more than a FG with an 0-4 team but New Mexico St took some heavy money from a sharp betting syndicate earlier this week. Hawaii got a win and cover last week but were outplayed vs FCS Duquesne. We're not involved yet.

Utah 33 ARIZONA ST 18. Herm Edwards is out at Arizona St after last week's shocking upset loss to Eastern Michigan as 20.5-point favorites. RB coach Shaun Aguano will serve as the interim. Not sure there could be a taller first task in the Pac-12 than the Utes who have buried their last two opponents. We bet Utah -12 on the openers and still lean that way.

2★ Oregon St (plus the points) USC 37 OREGON ST 34. It's tough to believe but USC has exceeded their lofty preseason expectations so far. The Trojans are 3-0 ATS covering their games by 13 ppg. The offense is averaging 51 ppg and 520 ypg with QB Caleb Williams completing 74% of his passes with a 8-0 ratio. Still, the defense has allowed more than 400 yards in back-to-back weeks and the Trojans are No. 1 in TO margin at +10. Meanwhile, the Beavers are also 3-0 ATS covering by 14 ppg. We like the Beavers as USC can't continue to rely on TO luck.

Toledo 24 SAN DIEGO ST 23. A lot of money has come in on Toledo in the last 24 hours from a market influencer. San Diego St is 0-3 ATS failing to cover by 10.3 ppg. However, we can't lay 3 with Toledo making the long road trip.

Oregon 32 WASHINGTON ST 23. Some may point out that Oregon QB Bo Nix struggles on the road. That might be true but he's not facing an SEC team here. Yes, Washington St is 3-0 SU but we haven't been overly impressed with the Cougars. They got outgained by 148 yards in the upset of Wisconsin. Had they lost that game even by 1 point, we think Oregon is laying 9 here. Value on the Ducks.

California 26 ARIZONA 23. That was a really impressive win by Arizona last week beating FCS power North Dakota St. That's two upsets already by Arizona this season. They're taking on a Cal team that was worse than the final vs both UC Davis and UNLV. Last week they played an emotional to the wire game vs ND. We bet Arizona +4 but can't at the current numbers.

WASHINGTON 37 Stanford 24. Washington is an entirely different team under first year head coach Kalen DeBoer. The Huskies are 3-0 ATS covering by 8.3 ppg. Last year's offense averaged just 22 ppg and 323 ypg. This year's offense is averaging 45 ppg and 548 ypg. A market influencer took Washington yesterday driving this number up. As of now, we're not involved.

Marshall 29 TROY 24. In a clear let-down spot after beating Notre Dame, Marshall lost outright to Bowling Green last week in OT. Still, they did outgain BG by 170 yards but were -3 in TO's. Meanwhile, Troy lost on a "Hail Mary" to Appalachian St. Tough game. We're passing.

SOUTH ALABAMA 36 Louisiana Tech 25. South Alabama is 3-0 ATS this year covering by 20.7 ppg. Last week, they almost shocked UCLA. However, we thought there was a big premium on the openers and we took Louisiana Tech +15. Totals' players note the OVER is a combined 6-0 in games involving these two teams.

MISSISSIPPI ST 44 Bowling Green 14. BG comes in off the big upset win over Marshall while Miss St is off an upset loss to LSU where their offense got bogged down in the second half. We expect the Bulldogs to rebound here. We like OVER with BG's defense allowing 538 ypg.

OKLAHOMA 34 Kansas St 21. After Oklahoma's blowout win over Nebraska and Kansas St's upset loss to Tulane, we thought this might be a good "Buy Low, Sell High" spot. The problem is the opener was OU -13 and hasn't moved at all.

OLE MISS 41 Tulsa 21. We're a little surprised to see this cross through "21". We lean Tulsa who got bet by a sharp syndicate last week and covered by 25 points. We've also seen OVER money this week with Tulsa games 3-0 to the OVER by 16 ppg. Note Ole Miss games are on a 10-1 run to the UNDER though.

ALABAMA 50 Vanderbilt 10. We like OVER here. Vandy games are 4-0 to the OVER this season by an average of 13.3 ppg. They went to true frosh QB AJ Swann last week and threw 4 TD passes as the Commodores have already passed their season win total. Look for the Alabama defense to have a field day vs the Vandy defense that has struggled the last 3 games.

Tcu 35 SMU 33. The big story here is new TCU head coach Sonny Dykes taking on his former team. Dykes recruited a lot of those SMU players so he should know their strengths and weaknesses. TCU comes in off a bye. Lean TCU.

Texas 32 TEXAS TECH 27. Texas is getting a lot of love after the near Alabama upset and a win and cover last week. Note it was a 24-20 game last week vs UTSA when a 44-yard interception return in the final seconds of the 3Q changed momentum. Meanwhile, Texas Tech outgained NC State 353-270 but were done in by a -3 TO margin. Lean Texas Tech.

UL-Lafayette 31 UL-MONROE 21. A remarkable series trend here is that the visitor is 20-2-1 ATS. ULL comes in off the upset loss to Rice in which they were outgained by 274 yards. A sharp betting syndicate gave out ULM and drove the number down through 10. We don't see much value.

† **Texas A&M 24 Arkansas 23.** @AT&T Stadium in Arlington, TX. A change in QB didn't help the Aggies offense too much last week as they managed just 264 yards in a win over Miami. The Aggies were outgained by 128 yards. Meanwhile, in a clear flat spot, Arkansas struggled with Missouri St. We're not involved here yet.

HOUSTON 38 Rice 20. Rice comes in off the big upset win over ULL while Houston comes in off the upset loss to Kansas. Seems like a good "Buy Low, Sell High" spot but the market is in line with our power ratings. We do like OVER. It is a combined 6-0 in the two teams' games this year.

MEMPHIS 38 North Texas 27. Memphis games are 3-0 to the OVER this year while North Texas is allowing 503 ypg. Both side and total seem reasonably priced.

2★ Southern Miss (plus the points) TULANE 30 Southern Miss 20. Southern Miss is quietly 3-0 ATS on the season covering by 9 ppg. Tulane is also 3-0 ATS covering by 13.5 ppg but are coming off the big upset win over Kansas St last week and could be in a flat spot here.

AUBURN 30 Missouri 23. Note that Auburn QB TJ Finley will not play in this game as the Tigers will go to Robby Ashford. Auburn is already 0-3 ATS on the season failing to cover by 15.5 ppg. Head coach Bryan Harsin was already on the hot seat entering the season. Is he a lame duck after the blowout loss to Penn St?

WESTERN KENTUCKY 45 Fiu 17. Big line mover here as WKU opened -26 and the total 60.5 (we can't play the current numbers). The Hilltoppers should have beat Indiana last week as they had a post-game win expectancy of 89%. They'll have no problem here vs a FIU team that we power rate dead last in the country.

Unlv 31 UTAH ST 29. UNLV is 3-0 ATS covering their games by 14.3 ppg. Meanwhile, Utah St is 0-3 ATS failing to cover by 20.3 ppg. It probably shouldn't be a surprise then to see UNLV go from a 1-point underdog to a 2.5-point favorite this week. However, we haven't got to the window yet.

Purdue 39 Florida Atlantic 21. Purdue might be the best 1-2 team in the country. They could have beat Penn St in the opener and should have beat Syracuse last week as they had a 485-306 yard edge. FAU took a bunch of money last week in the market but that proved wrong in their blowout loss. Another game we didn't bet yet.

LSU 39 New Mexico 8. Tough spot for LSU off the big win vs Miss St with a ton of big SEC games on deck. New Mexico forced 7 TO's last week and are allowing just 230 ypg and 14 ppg.

SAN JOSE ST 28 Western Michigan 22. We bet San Jose -3 on the openers but didn't expect the line to get this high. We lean WMU +7.

Week 4 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 11-10.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Baylor +3**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, September 22nd

Cleveland 21 PITTSBURGH 17. The Browns blew a 13 point lead in the final 1:22 to lose to the Jets 31-30. NFL teams had won the last 2,229 consecutive games when leading by at least 13 points in the final 2 minutes. The last team to blow such a lead? The Browns in week 9 of the 2001 season vs the Bears. Slight lean to the Steelers here but note they have been outgained by 149 ypg so far this season. Also check the weather forecast with near 20 mph wind in the forecast.

Sunday, September 25th

Baltimore 23 NEW ENGLAND 20. How does Baltimore rebound after the shocking loss to Miami last week? The Ravens led by 21 but their defense had several coverage breakdowns late. Meanwhile, New England (-3) won at Pittsburgh 17-14, winning yardage 376-243, yards-per-play 5.7 to 4.2 and rushing 124-91. We see this game right near the number on both side and total.

Buffalo 28 MIAMI 23. The Dolphins came back from 21 down to shock Baltimore last week. Tua's 6 TD's tied Dan Marino and Bob Griese for most TD passes in a game in Dolphins history. How about new Miami coach Mike McDaniel beating Bill Belichick and John Harbaugh in his first two games. Meanwhile, the Bills destroyed the Titans on MNF. There have been 201 instances in NFL history of a team facing a playoff team from the previous season in each of their 1st 2 games. The Bills' +55 is the largest point differential of any of them. Safe to say they might be the best team in the league. We didn't get involved here.

Cincinnati 25 N.Y. JETS 19. The Super Bowl loser hangover is alive and well in Cincinnati with the Bengals off to an 0-2 start losing outright as a TD favorite in both games. Meanwhile, the Jets had the miraculous comeback vs Cleveland. Seems like a good "Buy Low" spot for the Bengals but they can't protect QB Burrow allowing 13 sacks already.

New Orleans 22 CAROLINA 20. The Panthers first two games this season saw them lose via a go-ahead 58-yd FG and a go-ahead 56-yd FG. Carolina is the first team to allow go-ahead 55+ yard FG in the 4th qtr/OT in consecutive games in NFL history. That screams value for us especially against a banged up Saints team. With such a low total, we think Carolina is a good teaser option.

MINNESOTA 30 Detroit 24. The Lions leave a lot to be desired defensively under head coach Dan Campbell (allowed at least 30 points in 8 of 18 games) but they do cover point spreads. That's now 9 of their last 11 after beating Washington last week. Meanwhile, the Vikings were humbled on MNF in Philly. We expect a lot of points here but don't see value in the side.

1★ Indy (plus the points) Kansas City 26 INDIANAPOLIS 23.

The Colts were shut out 24-0 against the Jaguars. It was the third time since 1994 the Colts have been shut out in a football game, all three of which have come at the hands of the Jaguars. Matt Ryan was sacked five times and intercepted three times. Who in their right mind would want to bet the 0-1-1 Colts vs the 2-0 Chiefs? We do as we think there's been too much of an over-reaction with KC -3 on the look-ahead lines.

TENNESSEE 23 Las Vegas 22. Obviously, both playoff teams from last year are in desperation mode at 0-2. We can't believe the Raiders blew that game last week after leading by 20. How does WR Davante Adams only get two catches? We trust Vrabel to get issues corrected better than Josh McDaniels who just may not be head coach material. Tennessee would be a great teaser option up to +8. Tough seeing them blown out at home in a must-win.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Philadelphia 25 WASHINGTON 21. The Eagles are favored by more than a field goal on the road coming off a short week and a big win on MNF. Certainly not an ideal spot. Meanwhile, Ron Rivera won't be getting a Christmas card anytime soon after blowing the teaser vs Detroit. We lean Washington here.

CHICAGO 21 Houston 20. Lovie Smith returns to Chicago where he was the head coach from 2004-2012. He's doing a good job so far this season with a tie vs Indy as TD underdogs and last week the Texans gave Denver all they could handle. Meanwhile, Chicago was thumped in Green Bay. A respected market influencer likes Houston as one of his top plays of the year and that's a big reason why we saw this number come off a key "3" earlier. We prefer Houston in a teaser.

L.A. CHARGERS 27 Jacksonville 20. How healthy is QB Justin Herbert? He looked really banged up at the end of the Chiefs game but did have a few extra days to rest. The Jags have exceeded expectations so far but how do they fare off a rare win? We think the line is about right on this one.

2★ Green Bay 21 TAMPA BAY 20. Tampa Bay will be without WR Mike Evans for this game and they are also banged up on the offensive line. Yes, their defense has looked great so far but now they face a healthy offense for the first time as Dak got hurt in the opener and the Cowboys were banged up on the OL and last week the Saints were without Kamara. Meanwhile, Green Bay rebounded after Week 1 and looked the part vs Chicago. The Packers are healthier and have the better coach. Green Bay is yet another great teaser option with a low total.

SEATTLE 21 Atlanta 20. Even at 0-2, the Falcons have far exceeded expectations so far with near upsets of the Saints and Rams. They're taking a big step down in class here. Seattle is 1-1 but the Seahawks have been outgained by 169 ypg so far this season. Going to sound like a broken record but with such low totals, we love teasing the underdog up through key numbers of 3 and 7. Also note the Falcons are practicing in Seattle all week instead of flying back to Atlanta after the L.A. game.

L.A. Rams 25 ARIZONA 23. Something to put in your back-pocket for later this season. Each of the last SEVEN times Arizona has been a road underdog, it has won the game outright. That is tied with 1980-81 Seattle for the longest win streak as a road underdog in the Super Bowl era. This time rallying from a 20-point deficit. It was highlighted by Kyler Murray running a total distance of 85.69 yards on the successful 2-point conversion rush. Quite simply, the Rams don't look right this season so far. How can you lay more than a FG on the road with them?

1★ DENVER 23 San Francisco 22. Last week Denver was +1.4 in yards per play, +120 in yards, but were 0-2 in the red zone and had another 100+ yards of penalties. Their stats are dominant so far at +148 ypg on the season but they also look poorly coached (so far). Meanwhile, it's back to Jimmy G for the 49ers who won and covered last week for us. We like Denver in a teaser here and remember the look-ahead line had Denver -3. That screams over-reaction to us.

Monday, September 26th

Dallas 21 N.Y. GIANTS 20. Dallas took some big-time money today from a market influencer bringing the line down to +1. The Cowboys have dominated the Giants beating them nine of the past 10 times, going 8-2 ATS. Cooper Rush is now 2-0 as a starter the last couple of years. Can you really trust the Giants to move to 3-0.
