

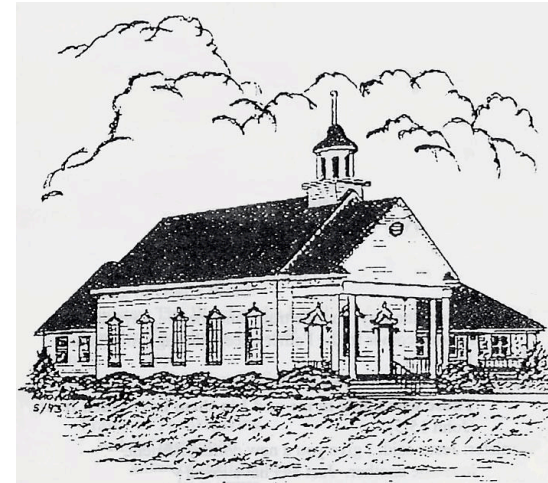

Call to Worship and Prayer of Invocation
