

ARTHUR C. REINHOLD 1904 - 1993

Arthur C. Reinhold, 89, longtime Sebawaing civic and business leader, died Sunday evening, Nov. 28, at Tendercare of Cass City, following a brief illness.

He was born Jan. 17, 1904, in Sebawaing, the son of Gustav and Lydia (Knecht) Reinhold. He was married to Helen Kunding in Sebawaing on Sept. 16, 1928, and she survives him.

Mr. Reinhold served as village trustee in 1942 and was re-elected until 1946. Then he became village president, and was re-elected annually until 1971, serving as president for 25 years.

Mr. Reinhold attended Alma College before going to Germany to study brickmaking. He helped construct a brick company in Montreal, and was employed at Sebawaing Sandstone Brick Company from 1918 until he purchased it in 1946. He then operated the company until his retirement in 1975.

He was a member of New Salem Lutheran Church and was a longtime member of Sebawaing Chamber of Commerce.

Surviving, besides his wife, Helen, are one son and daughter-in-law, Arthur G. "Red" and Sandra Reinhold of Sebawaing, three grandchildren, two step-grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Two sisters, Elsa Reinhold and Erma Fisher, and a half-brother, Frank Schultz, preceded him in death.

The funeral service will take place at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 1 (tomorrow) at New Salem Lutheran Church, Sebawaing. Rev. Keith Siverly will officiate and burial will be in Silverlawn Cemetery.

Friends may call at Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing, from 9 am to 9 pm Tuesday (today) and he will lie in state at the church from 9:30 am Wednesday until the time of service.
