

The keyboard provides a *visual range* of the lowest to highest music notes.

The grand staff has a treble staff and bass staff joined by a brace.

The musical alphabet consists of 7 letter names (A, B, C, D, E, F and G).

This note sequence <u>repeats</u> 7 times. The C's on the keyboard below and their position on the grand staff are shown starting with the lowest on the left.





In navigating the piano keyboard there are two landmarks on the keyboard, C is found before every group of 2 black keys, and F is found before every group of 3 black keys.

Write all the C's and F's on the keyboard.



The group of 2 black keys gives us the notes CDE.

Write all the C D E's on the keyboard.



G A B follows the F landmark.

Write all the GAB's on the keyboard.



Name the notes marked with an x on the keyboard.
