



Increase

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt.

6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17), and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight

(Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Lord bless you and your house and keep you (Num. 6:24). Glory to God in the highest! (Luke 2:14) We do not come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on the worthiness of you and your family but by Jesus Christ whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) We come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)! Do not hide Your face from Your servants, O Lord; hear us speedily. (Ps. 69:17) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) to help you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed, and all of your spiritual seed. Grace, mercy, and peace be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. (2 John 1:3) Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the King of Israel (John 12:13), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon our Father God and we ask that God would bless you indeed, and enlarge your territory, that His Hand would be with you, and that He would keep you from evil, that you not cause pain. God bless you indeed. (1Chr. 4:10) Of the

increase of your house and peace may there be no end, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from this time forward, even forever. (Is. 9:7) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you find favor in the sight of God and He will increase His mercy toward you and your house. (Gen. 19:19) May it come to pass that God Almighty will send hornets before you and your family, which shall drive out your enemies from before you (Ex. 23:28). Little by little He will drive them out from before you and your house, until you and your family have increased, and you and your house inherit the land. (Ex. 23:30) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray He will love you and your family and bless you and your loved ones and multiply you and your house (Deut. 7:13). So you and your family shall rejoice in every good thing which the Lord your God has given to you and your house, you and the church and the stranger who is among you. (Deut. 26:11) The Lord your God will make you and your people abound in all the work of your hands. (Deut. 30:9) The Lord will rejoice over you and your house for good, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your possessions, and in the produce of your land for good. (Deut. 30:9) He has made with you and your house an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things and secure, and He will make it increase (2 Sam. 23:5). As a co-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), we ask in Jesus' name (John 16:23), the Lord, your Savior, and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob (Is. 49:26), that the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) make a hedge around you, around your household, and around all that you have on every side and bless the work of your hands and make your possessions increase. (Job 1:10) As your riches increase, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family do not set your hearts on them (Ps. 62:10), but earnestly seek God and make your supplication to the Almighty, that you and your family will be found pure and upright, surely now God will awake for you, and prosper your rightful habitation (Job 8:5-6). God Almighty, El

Shaddai (Gen. 17:1) grant though your beginning is small, your latter end will increase abundantly. (Job 8:7) For your seed shall be prosperous, the vine shall give its fruit, the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew. God will cause you and yours to possess all these things. (Zech. 8:12) Praise the Lord your God. Then the earth shall yield her increase, God, our own God, shall bless you and your house. (Ps. 67:6) The Lord has been mindful of you and your family; He will bless you; He will bless your house. He will bless those who fear the Lord, both small and great. (Ps. 115:12-13) May the Lord give you increase more and more, You and your children. May you be blessed by the Lord, Who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15). God shall bless you and your house, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him. (Ps. 67:7) The Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of His hands; they will perish, but He remains; and they will all grow old like a garment; like a cloak He will fold them up, and they will be changed. But He is the same, and His years will not fail. (Heb. 1:10-12) Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom. (Heb. 1:8) Praise the Lord!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), His name is exalted (Is. 12:4), now may the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:2), increase your faith (Luke 17:5), that your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other (2 Thess. 1:3). You and your house will abound with blessings (Prov 28:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will give all diligence to add to your faith, virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. For these things are yours and abound in you. (2 Pet. 1:5-8) Now may the God of hope fill you and your people

with all joy and peace in believing, that you and your house may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 15:13) May the Lord God increase your joy. (Is. 29:19) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will abound in everything in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in love and in grace. (2 Cor. 8:7). God is able to make all grace abound toward you and your family, that you and your house, always having all sufficiency in all things, have an abundance for every good work. (2 Cor. 9:8). God of peace (1 Thess. 5:23) increase you and your house all the more in strength (Acts 9:22). May the Most High, and the Ancient of Days (Dan 7:22), lift up a banner over you and your house. (Ps. 60:40) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord your God to bring you and your family to the banqueting house, and let His banner over you be love (Song. 2:4). May God increase you and your house greatly, and make you and your people stronger than your enemies. (Ps. 105:24) According to the integrity of His heart (Ps. 78:72, Jer. 3:15) may God make you and your house be fruitful and increase (Jer. 23:3) abundantly, multiply and grow exceedingly mighty (Ex. 1:7), and produce a hundred fold (Mark 4:8). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray the Lord will increase your greatness and comfort you and your house on every side (Ps. 71:21), joy and gladness will be found in you, thanksgiving and the voice of melody (Is. 51:3). Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, being enriched in all liberality. (2 Cor. 9:10) May the Lord God give the rain for your seed for which you sow, and bread of the increase of the earth; it will be fat and plenteous (Is. 30:23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will honor the Lord with your possessions, and with the first fruits of all your increase (Prov. 3:9), so that you will scatter, yet increase more (Prov. 11:24). Mercy and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. Truth shall spring

out of the earth, and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and your land will yield its increase. Righteousness will go before Him, and shall make His footsteps your pathway. (Ps. 85:10-13) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord (1 Cor. 15:58). Let you and your family gather by labor and increase (Prov. 13:11), and you will receive your own reward according to your own labor (1 Cor. 3:8). So that men will say, "Surely there is a reward for the righteous; surely He is God who judges in the earth." (Ps. 58:11)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), may God give the increase (1 Cor. 3:6). May you and your house grow with the increase that is from God (Col. 2:19), and expand all your borders (Is. 26:15). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray the Lord will make you and your family increase and abound in love to one another and to all, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints (1 Thess. 3:12-13). Concerning brotherly love (1 Thess. 4:9) may you and yours increase more and more (1 Thess. 4:10). And this in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that you and your people may approve the things that are excellent, that you and your family may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. (Phil. 1:9-11) Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting! Amen and Amen. (Ps. 41:13)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), in His name may you and your house increase in wisdom and stature, and in favor with

God and men. (Luke 2:52) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will know wisdom and instruction, to perceive the words of understanding, to receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity, prudence, knowledge and discretion. May you and your house hear and increase learning (Prov. 1:2-5). Now thanks be to God who always leads you and your house in triumph in Christ, and through you and your people diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. For you and your family are to God the fragrance of Christ. (2 Cor. 2:14-15) Grace and peace be multiplied to you and your house in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to you and your family all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called you and your people by glory and virtue, by which have been given to you exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family are diligent to make your calling and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to you and your people abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Pet. 1:10-11). Let you and your family increase your joy in the Lord, and rejoice In the Holy One of Israel. (Is. 29:19) Then you and your people will go to the altar of God, to God your exceeding joy; and praise Him. (Ps. 43:4)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve

Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house

are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). We ask our Father in heaven, in the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Messenger of the covenant (Mal. 3:1), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God, and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9); for it is written: "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it. For God will save Zion and build the cities of Judah, that they may dwell there and possess it. Also, the descendants of His servants shall inherit it, and those who love His name shall dwell in it. (Ps. 69:35-36) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
