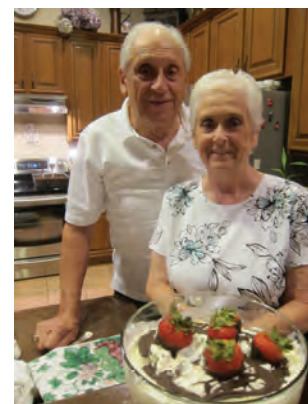

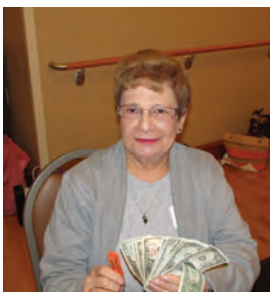
## "On-the-Towners"
