### Submission Guidelines

- SAGA receives submissions from June 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>.
- SAGA student editors are committed to showcasing and promoting Long Beach City College student work as well as presenting new work by established authors.

- Simultaneous submissions are accepted. Please contact the managing editor immediately if your manuscript is accepted for publication elsewhere.
- Our submission deadline is December 31, 2020. The Volume Six publication date and reception will occur in Spring 2021.

### Short Fiction, Poetry, and Nonfiction Guidelines

- Only one fiction or nonfiction submission is allowed per reading period. For fiction and non-fiction works, no more than a 5,000 word-count will be accepted. For shorter works of fiction, 3 short works may be submitted but must not exceed a 5,000 total word-count.
- No single poem should be longer than 50 lines each, and only 3 poems may be submitted.
- All fiction and non-fiction must be typed, double spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font, and saved as a Microsoft Word document. Please number consecutive pages of a single work.

**SAGA Literary Journal** acquires first serial rights on accepted pieces; copyright reverts to the author after publication. Like most small, institutionally sponsored journals, we do not pay selected writers for their submissions except in publication and promotion of the writers' works featured in the journal. We do not consider previously published material.
