Required giveaway items will be used in opportunity drawings at the event and throughout the year in front of OPPA! audiences and students. Your business will also receive mentions at that time. No set value.

No Booth Sharing Allowed. All participants/products must go through the application process.

Booth Information:

Size: Indoor 8x8 indoor, Outdoor 10x10. Surface: parking lot asphalt. Power: None. Zero Emission battery-type generators are allowed (silent, no gas or fumes) Outdoor Canopies are recommended but not required. Canopy weights required on minimum of 2 legs. No booth sharing. All vendors must be prepared to have an indoor and outdoor set up option. NO guarantees will be given in advance for placement. TBD on number of vendors.

Vender Load in: 8:30-9:30. No vehicles in OPPA's parking lot/Vendor Area between 9:30a - 1:00p Must be fully set up by 10:00am

Booths are required to remain active during set vendor hours. Event will continue rain or shine.

For the success of the event, vendors are encouraged to share their social media handles with us and post about the event on their own platforms and websites to help with cross promotion.

Management reserves the right to limit the number of vendors in the same category, cancel and refund any paid application without notice, remove noncompliant vendors from an event without compensation.

All vendors are subject to County Health Department or property management COVID-19 guidelines. Failure to abide by these guidelines will be grounds for vendor termination without compensation

Vendors are not authorized to independently sell their spaces. Fees from any cancelations after October 1st will be considered a donation to OPPA!.
