- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 8, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is committed to the conservation of natural resources within the Summit Lake Indian Reservation and to the long-term protection, preservation and management of the Summit Lake watershed; and
- WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has funding for Tribes in an Indian General Assistance Program to assist them in administering Tribal environmental programs; and
- WHEREAS, obtaining Indian General Assistance Program funding would further the goals of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe through the actions of the Natural Resources Department.
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes, approves and consents to application for Environmental Protection Agency Indian General Assistance Program funding.
