Room Changes

As you may have noticed we have had some minor modifications to both Rainbowfish and Jellyfish over the summer. In Rainbowfish we have replaced the carpet with wet flooring, this will open up opportunities for further creative and messy play in this room. The staff have worked together to keep some areas of this room softer to allow quiet time for children.

In Jellyfish room we have removed the sleep room walls, we recognise that children still require sleep at this stage but we felt that the sleep room was taking up a large space which could be used to provide more play opportunities for children. Any children that still require a sleep will be able to find a cosy spot within the book area of Jellyfish where staff will be able to keep a close eye on them while they get their much needed rest.
