This passage reminds me of our children when they first arrive at our home. They have been taken away from their families. They have been hurt by people they should have been able to trust. They are in a strange environment. They don't know what is going to happen now, let alone tomorrow. These children are out of the boat. Peter got out voluntarily, knowing that a loving Savior was there to catch him. Most of our kids are out of the boat without the knowledge of a loving God. They just walk, already scared, frightened, and about to sink. They have no idea who to cry out to, they just cry out, "Save Me." That is where we all must intervene. There is a beautiful

hymn that paints a picture of what we try to do at New Life Children's home.
