We get a brand new, up to date (and code) building that will last a long time that we can use for numerous different functions throughout the year, not just the months the pool is open. Whether you use the facilities now or not, the new Cabana will enhance what is already a great place to live, and most likely, increase your property value by an amount considerably higher than the amount each resident will spend to get it built. Keep in mind that the Board has resisted raising the Association fees (which it can by 20% a year without a vote of the membership), knowing this was coming, in favor of an assessment that is going to be fair and equitable.

It's time for every owner in Fiesta Gardens to be part of the success of this project. We MUST replace the existing Cabana, it's a GREAT deal for the neighborhood, and we're ALL going to come out ahead. It's a WIN, WIN, WIN for everyone.
