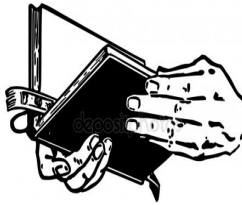

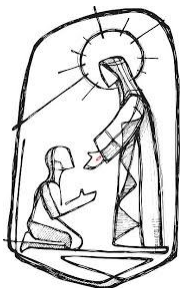

- ◆ Cleaning the current road of all grass to return it to the original size;
- ◆ Replace the dead laurel bushes in the hedge.

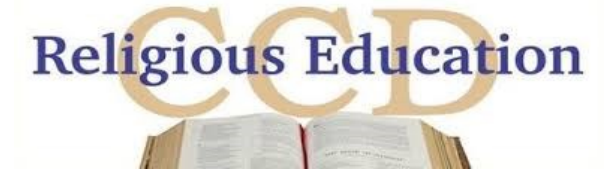
PRAYER VIGIL FOR OUR LADY'S BIRTHDAY
