What are the costs and benefits with an even comparison of alternatives?

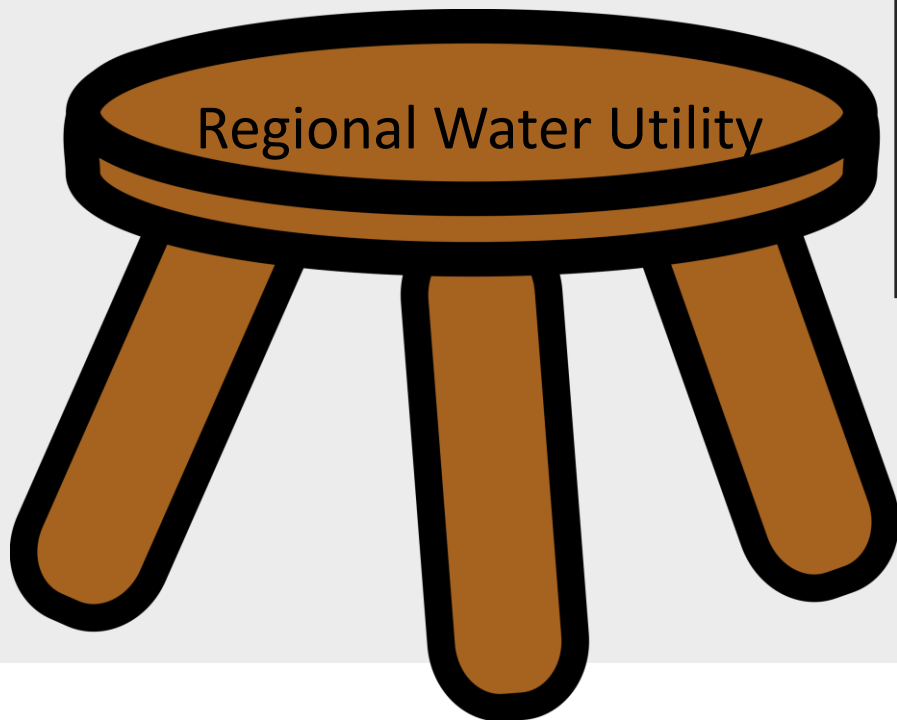


Service Level
