If you plan to attend please contact Lin Heimrick (910-315-4090) by June 17 so that we can let the restaurant know the size of our group.

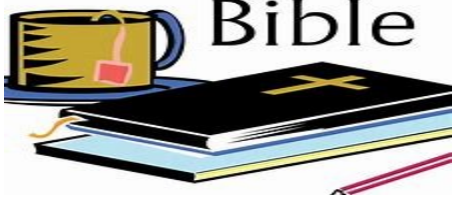

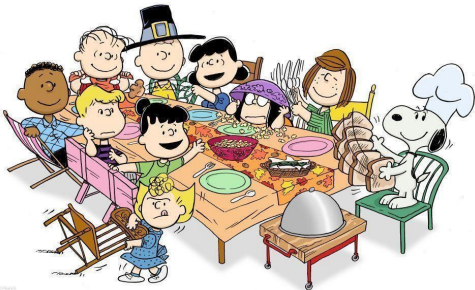
