PRESIDENT NOTES

Cape Coral Bass Club next meeting is scheduled for October 6th,
7:30 pm at Nemo's. Again, no points will be awarded for
attending so not to penalize those practicing staying away from

groups. Get there early and patronize the bar. The food and drink are good.

Please mail in your entry fees to Lori early. As she receives the check, she notes the order they arrive and your name will be entered onto the tournament sign-up sheet until Tuesday October 6th, prior to the meeting. Those attending the meeting and electing to pay there will then sign the sheet on the next available line. Boat numbers will be drawn at the meeting and a list will be published. You need not be present at the meeting for the drawing (again not to penalize.) As most of you are aware that all regular club tournaments are \$30 per person and has been for the past three years. The club tournament rules still reflect the previous fee of \$25 which is incorrect and will be updated soon.

The two day Okeechobee tournament is 2 one day back to back tournaments so as to recover from the lost day in April. The Okeechobee weekend is \$60 plus \$10 per person side pot (side pot optional as always). Which means the winning three weights on Saturday get a check and the winning three weights on Sunday get a check since they are two entirely different tournaments. Check the website for lodging info.

Any payment after the meeting or made at the ramp will cause your boat to be added to the end of the boat drawn list in the order received. For now, we waive the \$5 late entry.

We are also collecting for the upcoming mini-bucks elimination round on the 17th. The fee is \$25 plus optional side pot \$5 and the Team Trail tournament #4 on October 24th which is \$50 for each boat and \$10 optional side pot (\$60). Registrations are in place for the Cape Coral Bass Club/Lee County Sheriff's Office November 14th tournament. The entry fee is \$100 plus \$10 for optional side pot.
