Visitation Update

Good Morning Midway Nursing Home Residents & Loved Ones –

Yesterday, we received positive COVID result for a staff member. With NYSDOH guidance and out of an abundance of caution, we have quarantined residents as required.

In person visitation will now be put on “pause” for at least 14 days but we will have window visits as scheduled. Residents on isolation for any reason and those on quarantine are not allowed to have visitors.

Virtual visits remain available. Please contact Social Work or Recreation to arrange this. Our new tablets have arrived so additional virtual visit time is available and encouraged. Virtual visits are available 7 days a week.

Window visits must be scheduled in advance according to the usual unit schedule. Visitation is limited to two persons and all visitors must wear a facemask at all times while on facility premises.

We will keep you advised when limited in person visitation may resume.
