

Opportunities to Support Immigrants

The Immigrant Support Task Force appreciates the support of the larger St. Cecilia's community in declaring us to be a Supporting Sanctuary Church. There is good work to be done and there are many ways to become involved. The Following events are especially meaningful.

Monthly Prayer Vigil (Ecumenical service with 6 other Sanctuary Churches)

Sunday, May 21st, at 7:00 pm at First Congregational Church, 500 8th Ave SE. Minneapolis.

Besides meeting wonderful people committed to helping immigrants you will experience a different faith tradition each month. Last month the Vigil was held at St. Francis Cabrini and the service emphasized Catholic Social teachings.

Rapid Response Training. This is an opportunity to become a trained observer to document ICE enforcement actions on behalf of the immigrants being detained.

Sunday, June 4th, from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at University Baptist Church, 1219 University Avenue, SE. This training is being held to establish a metro wide network of trained observers who are called to witness a detention event close to where the observers live. Volunteer observers are "on call" for one or more shifts a week to respond. We especially need volunteers who speak Spanish and who would consider being a multilingual dispatcher for the network.

There are other ways to become involved. Please call or email me at any time if you are interested in helping out this very important social justice calling.

Four Key Ways to Support Immigrants

- 1. **Engage in Relationship Building.** This would include attending events and activities with immigrants such as soccer games and picnics; mass at immigrant congregations, prayer vigils, etc.
- 2. Attend (help plan) education and training sessions, public discussions, and Spanish classes.
- 3. **Volunteer to Provide Specific Help.** Become a Rapid Responder and/or member of Rescue Brigade, etc. Raise funds. Attend rallies. Provide individual support to immigrants. (See above opportunity.)
- 4. **Help plan and/or attend prayer vigils** and other forms of spiritual support for the immigrant community. (See above opportunity.)
