

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2016-02

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE PAY FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES,
REPEALING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Amelia Village employs a significant number of full-time and part-time employees within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has recommended to Council, that wages and salaries of most employees, employed as of January 1, 2016 be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. That the following wages and salaries be paid to Village employees effective January 11, 2016.

SECTION II. All prior Resolutions or Ordinances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said Resolutions or ordinances not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order that the Village employees are compensated at competitive rates of pay. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the

affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MR. DICKERSON seconded the motion.
